2021-2022 8th/9th Grade Registration – Registration packets for the 2021-2022 school year were distributed to current 7th & 8th grade students in CCA and U.S. History classes on **February 22 & 23**. Students and parents should fill out and return the Course Request Form to the Counseling Center or the Main Office no later than **Friday, March 4, 2021** for the best chance of getting the courses you would like. Course requests turned in after March 4 will be marked late and will have less chance to get the courses requested. If no course request is submitted a computer-generated course request will be created for your student.


