2021-2022 IMMUNIZATION CHECKLIST

Elementary registration is not complete until your child has completed required examinations, immunizations and health screenings.

Elementary students need:

- A health exam/physical within one year of starting kindergarten or when entering the IL school system for the first time.
- Proof of basic immunizations and required boosters for:

Diphtheria	Polio	Rubella
Tetanus	Red Measles	Varicella
Pertussis	Mumps	Haemophilus Influenzae Type B

- Proof of lead screening before entering kindergarten.
- An oral health/dental exam before May 15 during their kindergarten (K) **and** second (2nd) grade school year.
- Kindergarten eye exam: Students enrolling in kindergarten must have an eye exam before the first day of school.

Objections: Parents/guardians who object to required examinations or immunizations must submit an Illinois Certificate of Religious Exemption from their doctor's office.
