Job Description

Head coaches are responsible for teaching the fundamentals of individual sports, practice planning. Head Coaches work with the Archbishop Riordan Athletic Department in scheduling of non-league games, assisting with maintenance of practice and game facilities, to hire assistants (for Varsity and lower level teams), operate camps, and manage administrative responsibilities for your team and program.

In addition, all of our coaches serve as role models and mentors for players, encouraging their development academically, physically, emotionally and spiritually. A candidate must possess strong organizational skills and have experience building successful teams and working cross functionally with administration, teachers, assistant coaches, student-athletes and parents. He or she must also understand, implement and abide by the policies set forth in the <u>Archbishop Riordan Student</u> <u>Handbook</u> with regard to coach and student athlete behavior on and off the field.

Requirements

- Previous coaching experience at the high school or college level preferred.
- Demonstrated knowledge of the rules and regulations of high school sports, and understanding of the mission and vision of Archbishop Riordan High School.
- Candidates must be available after school hours through the conclusion of practice time, and for extended periods on weekends and game days. Coaches are required to attend all practices, team contests, and year-round athletic meetings as required.

• Candidates with teaching experience are strongly encouraged to apply as teaching positions may become available.

Additional Requirements for Head Coach Positions

- Bachelor's degree preferred.
- Demonstrated record of successfully managing teams and other coaching personnel.
- Reports directly to the Archbishop Riordan Athletic Department: Dean of Student Affairs, and Athletic Directors.
- Works with the Archbishop Riordan Athletic Department in preparing and monitoring the annual program budget, including equipment and uniforms.
- Attends mandatory Archbishop Riordan events, including athletic department meetings, the Fall Open House, and other events as needed.
- Supervises all members of their respective coaching staff.
- Understands and implements school policies, and <u>Central Coast Section</u> (CCS) and <u>California</u> <u>Interscholastic Federation</u> (CIF) rules and regulations regarding student eligibility.
- With the Archbishop Riordan Athletic Department, evaluates the coaching staff on an annual basis in accordance with Department guidelines for best practices in coaching.
- Coordinates as needed with school departments, including the President, Principal, Dean of Academics, Dean of Students, Faculty, RSP Staff, Counseling and Campus Ministry staff regarding student academic eligibility and successful participation in athletics.
- With the Archbishop Riordan Athletic Department in coordinatingand operating Winter and Summer Camps
- With the Archbishop Riordan Athletic Department, coordinates scheduling of practices and athletic contests, and transportation as needed.
- With the Archbishop Riordan Athletic Department, Equipment Manager and Trainer, ensures best practices with regard to the use and replacement of equipment, and ensures safety precautions are taken at all time to protect athletes.
- With the Archbishop Riordan Athletic Department, manages record keeping of all athletic contests, and supervises score reporting to various media outlets.
- With the Archbishop Riordan Athletic Department, reports and documents all newly hired coaches to school personnel, and ensures that all new coaches are fingerprinted and cleared through the San Francisco Archdiocesan <u>"VIRTUS" Program</u>.
- While in season, meets weekly with the Archbisop Riordan Athletic Department to ensure that program goals are met.
