Resource Specialist Program

Responsibilities include mentoring and supporting students during daily RSP study skills and English classes; facilitating communication between teachers, students and other support staff; administering accommodations during testing periods; supporting students during lunch-time and after-school homework support classes; and updating online tracking systems. We are seeking a candidate that can effectively communicate with students, teachers and parents and enjoys working in a collaborative and inclusive environment.
