PREPARING STUDENTS FOR SUCCESS

- Each student needs a foundation of critical thinking and problem-solving skills to succeed in advanced courses and outside of school
- East began building that foundation by implementing Pre-AP English and AP Human Geography as core courses for 9th graders
- We plan to continue building that foundation by implementing a Secondary Math 1 with an honors option for all, biology for 9th graders, and Pre-AP for 10th graders
- These changes will help reduce the opportunity gap at East by ensuring that each student has access to opportunities and develops the foundational skills they need
- These changes will increase opportunities and choice for each student, allowing them to develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills as they choose their own pathways and explore career trajectories that interest them
- The focus will shift from the traditional practice of valuing product over process to teaching 21st century skills that students need for college and their careers

WHY PRE-AP/AP CAPSTONE?

- To close the opportunity gap. AP is a nationally known and respected organization. East is the first school in Utah to adopt research-based Pre-AP courses, and the first in our district to adopt the AP Certificate and Capstone Diploma

- To shift the focus from quantity to quality
