

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY NOTIFICATION – California Education Code #48915(c)

Expulsion must be recommended for the following behaviors:

- 1) Possessing, selling, or otherwise furnishing a firearm.
- (2) Brandishing a knife at another person.
- (3) Unlawfully selling a controlled substance
- (4) Committing or attempting to commit a sexual assault or committing a sexual battery
- (5) Possession of an explosive.
