# VISION

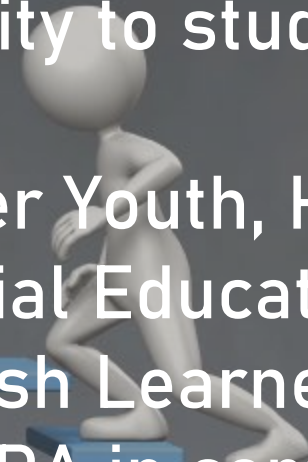
Within the high desert community, the WVC-WUHSD partnership will establish a new pathway for increased numbers of college-ready graduates.

1 DE course at LLA  
(2 college courses)

10<sup>th</sup> grade: Each semester  
1 DE on Campus  
1 VVC course at VVC  
(4 college courses)

11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade: Each  
Semester  
2 VVC courses at VVC  
(4 college courses)

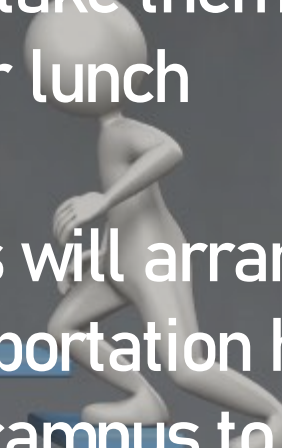
Students earn
