

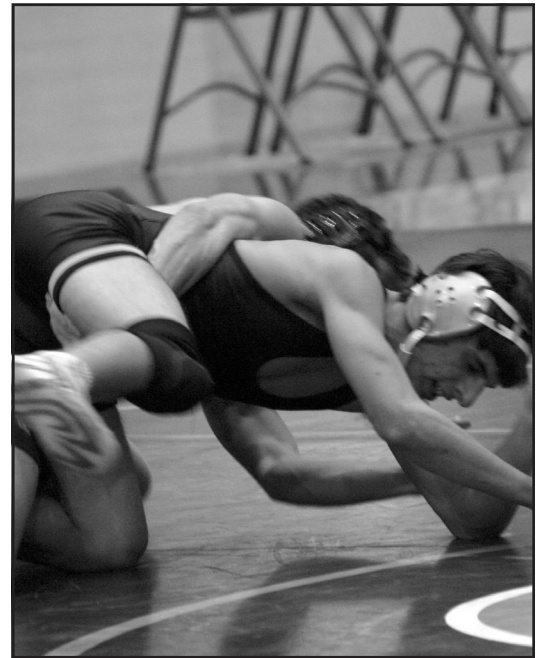
Varsity Wrestling
