Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- What is the Refund Policy? - *Due to the reliance upon expected numbers to plan for each activity, refunds will not be possible.*
- Will you offer Extended Hours? - *Unfortunately, we are unable to offer extended hours or after class/camp care at this time. Students must be picked up at 12:00 pm or 4:00 pm depending on when the selected activity ends. There will be a 20 minute window for picking up children. Students enrolled in both morning and afternoon sessions may remain on campus under supervision (or leave and return) from 12:00 pm - 1:00 pm.*
- Can I drop off my child late or pick up my child early before the class/activity ends? - *Yes, you are welcome to drop off your child late or pick them up before the class/activity ends (example: for a doctor's appointment). Just let us know your plans as we do attendance before each class/activity starts.*
- What snacks/meals do you provide? Will you be providing any? - *This summer, we will not be able to provide any snacks or meals for students.. Students are expected to bring their lunches every day if they are participating in both morning and afternoons and planning to stay on campus during the lunch hour. They will have a safe location to store their food (no refrigerators and microwave ovens will not be available).*
- What if my child can only attend some days of the class/activity? - *We are unable to prorate the class/activity fee. Please note, we do not offer refunds for missed days of camp. If your child is in grades 9-12 and attempting to earn 1.0 academic credit, missing a class or classes may impact their ability to receive that credit.*
- Are these activities allowed under local and state CoVID-related policies? - *Yes, they currently are..*
- What are your rules and processes for CoVID-related safety?
 - *Students must bring at least two appropriate face masks and wear one at all times when indoors. Should the need to remove the mask occur, they may briefly step outside alone to remove their mask for a short period of time. Extra masks will be made available should the other masks become damaged or missing.*
 - *Students in one class/activity should limit their interactions with peers from other class/activities unless they are enrolled in both.*
 - *A six-foot distancing rule will be maintained.*
 - *Food, drink, or other personal items will not be shared with one another.*
 - *If the student is ill or feeling symptoms of being ill, they must **stay home**.*
 - *Students will wash their hands with soap and water before and after the activity, (and when specifically directed by a teacher or staff member).*
 - *Restroom occupancy will be limited to one at a time. When entering the empty restroom in the Kirby building, the student should sanitize their hands and change the indicator tag to red. When leaving the restroom, the student should sanitize their hands and flip the indicator tag back to green.*

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- **BEFORE ARRIVING** - Students must use the Fever Free application prior to arriving to the Kirby campus. They will be checked in when they get dropped off. More specific information about this will be provided after registration.
- All participants must also conduct an at-home CoVID test each week. They should take a test in the early part of the week (M, T, W) in the week preceding the expected week of participation. This means that each student will need to submit a CoVID test (provided by Kirby) on either July 12, 13, or 14 in order to participate on the week of July 19. Then they must submit another CoVID test on July 19, 20, or 21 in order to participate for the week of July 26. More details about CoVID testing will be provided after registration.
- May I observe my child during the class/activity? - For all our classes, we are unable to accommodate any visiting observers due to safety protocols regarding CoVID. For Ultimate Frisbee Camp, please make arrangements with the coach first and be sure to maintain your distance from any non-household members.
