


Safety Protocols for Summer

Learning Recovery Programs

- Elevate Math is provided for students entering 3rd-7th grades
- **Springboard** is provided for students entering 1st- 4th grades
- ELD Classes are provided for students entering 4th-8th grades
- **B2K & B2First Classes** are provided for students entering Kinder & 1st grade
- Cadence Learning is provided for students entering 6th-8th grades
- SPED EYP Classes are provided for students with IEPs
- YMCA in partnership with ARUSD teachers will provide an enriching literacy-based summer program. This program will provide intense literacy, intentional SEL support, and enrichment-based programming.

Elevate Math

The EY Elevate Math program helps support students to prepare for Common Core 8 or Algebra equivalent. Led by a credentialed teacher with a teaching assistant. Students will strengthen math skills, learn about college, and start preparing now.


The Elevate Math program will serve 256 students in grades 3rd - 8th.



Jose Valdes Summer Math Institute

Jose Valdes Academy provides comprehensive math education to current 5th and 6th grade students to achieve academic success through basic skills, grade level and advanced courses. In addition, Jose Valdes Institute provides a summer math enrichment program for current 5th, 6th, and 7th grade students who exceed math standards.

The Jose Valdes Academy program will serve 370 students in grades 6th - 8th.



Springboard

Hands-on support is at the core of Springboard's mission. Alum Rock teachers receive personalized real-time coaching in preparation for Family-Educator Learning Accelerators — 5-10 week cycles during which teachers and parents make a plan to help children reach reading goals.

The Springboard program will serve 231 students in grades K-3 this summer, providing balanced literacy and guided reading support.



Cadence Learning

Cadence teachers see their mentor teacher's craft and moves—and have the opportunity to make them their own. Twice a week, by video conference, they join their mentor and same-grade colleagues for live professional development rooted in *exactly* what they're teaching that week. Teachers arrive to class uniquely prepared, confident, and invested in the content.

The Cadence program will serve 144 students in grades 6th-8th this summer, providing both math and reading instruction.



ELD Summer Program

ELD summer program is targeted to students that are designated English Language Learners. The program will help the ELL to achieve more through collaborative projects, critical thinking and activities that inspire meaningful thinking and sharing - thus addressing the four domains of reading, writing, speaking, and listening.

We will be using <u>Our World</u>, from National Geographic Learning. This program provides real world experiences with content that motivates, and includes photography, meaningful stories, readings, immersive videos, and incredible National Geographic explorers.

Through cross-curricular topics that challenge learners and deepen their understanding of the world in English.

The ELD program will serve 96 students in grades 4th-8th this summer.



Think Together Summer Camp

Think Together will provide a summer learning recovery program in the form of Summer Camp for 4 hours per day over 20 program days. Students will participate in a variety of activities including Physical Activity, Visual and Performing Arts, and Stem Enrichment.

The Think Together Summer Camp will serve 300 students in grades 1st - 5th this summer.



Sports For Learning Summer Camp

Summer Camp Program

Sports for Learning will deliver Social Emotional Learning (SEL) & Physical activities, nutrition education and whole student wellness as well as take part in fun round robin games and tournaments (Sports Camp).

The Sports For Learning Summer Camp will serve 128 students in grades 2nd - 5th this summer.

Program Integration

Sports for Learning will deliver their SEL & Physical Education activities on a rotational basis at our 6 elementary summer school sites (Painter, San Antonio, Hubbard, Linda Vista, Cassell and Lyndale).

The Sports For Learning Program Integration will serve an additional 640 students in grades 2nd - 5th this summer.

Bridge to K/Bridge to 1st Grade

The BTK Program is a 4 week half-day summer program, designed for students entering Kindergarten and First grade. The program teaches important skills needed to transition to school and beyond. A key component is parent education to build engagement in their child's educational journey.

The Bridge to Kindergarten program will serve 120 students entering Kindergarten and First Grade.

Special Education Extended School Year

Extended School Year (ESY) services are Special Education and related services provided to students with disabilities beyond the regular school year.

All students with disabilities must be considered for ESY services each year.

For some students, interruptions in the school schedule, such as summer break, will result in children with disabilities losing many of their basic skills. For those students, it may take them longer than their peers to get those skills back. ESY services are provided during breaks in the educational schedule to prevent this loss.

ESY is offered in order to maintain current progress on a student's IEP goals. We will serve approximately 125 students.
