At Greenwood Leadership Academy, the 2021 Bond for Tulsa Public Schools includes:

- » A digital marquee, parking lot resurfacing, and roof repairs;
- » Upgrades to the HVAC system to improve air quality;\*

- » New equipment, materials, and resources for fine arts and physical education; and
- » Safe, comfortable, and environmentally sustainable transportation.

\*HVAC and air quality repairs will be federally funded by the CARES Act.

#### PROPOSITION 2: STUDENT AND CLASSROOM TECHNOLOGY - \$772,221


- » Network and systems upgrades

- » Wellness and physical education




Project totals are estimates and will be adjusted to ensure projects are completed. Totals based on pupil count will be adjusted to reflect current enrollment.
