TOTAL INVESTMENT IN PHOENIX RISING ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL: \$1.1 MILLION

PROPOSITION 1: SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS - \$797,294

- » Security cameras and radios
- » Safe entry and door access control0
- » Parking lot, sidewalk, and exterior LED lighting
- » Roofing
- » Furniture
- » Air Quality/HVAC Replacements federally funded by the CARES Act
