

COVID-19 DASHBOARD | Spring Lake Park Schools

This dashboard is updated weekly on Fridays and represents a snapshot of the current situation and data.

All students continue to learn either full-time at school or online by choice. We continue to handle COVID-19 exposures on a case-by-case basis within classrooms and teams and working in consultation with our public health experts to identify individuals who must quarantine due to close contact.

We continue to follow [Minnesota's Safe Learning Plan](#) through the end of the school year.

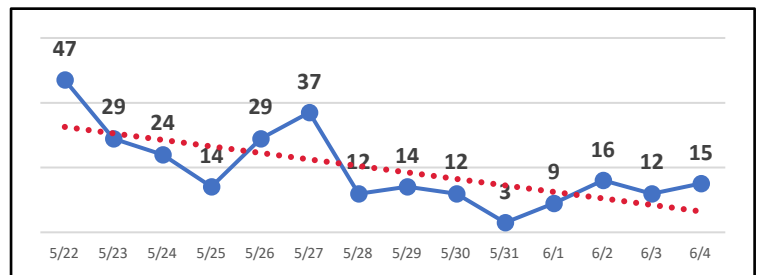
Spring Lake Park Schools Data

Data is for students and staff learning at school only. A school would only move to a more restricted learning model if infection rates reach or exceed 5 percent of the population. Otherwise, quarantine is handled on a case-by-case basis through contact tracing within teams and classrooms.

Anoka County daily new cases for the last 14 days

Because the 14-day case rate per 10,000 residents lags by two weeks, we also look at **total** daily new cases in the county for the last 14 days to preview what is coming. The [Minnesota Department of Health](#) reports case numbers each day for the previous day.

This is the number of people who test positive per 10,000 residents. This data reported on Thursdays by Minnesota Department of Health and lags by two weeks.
