

Share the PowerPoint slide entitled 'Thursday PSHE Jigsaw'. Look closely at the images of the two children where one is looking happy and the other is looking worried. Ask your child which one of these children is keeping a

good secret? How can they tell?

Discuss the feelings associated with keeping good secrets.

Now focus on the other child in the picture and explain that this child is keeping a 'worry secret'.

What do you think a good secret/worry secret both may be?

Explain to your child that good secrets help make us feel happy and usually lead to good surprises. But some secrets can make us worry and feel sad or frightened. These are 'worry' secrets.

PE

Learning objectives:

...to maintain a good 'ready position'. ...to lean forward to help move quickly. ...to move feet, rather than stretch

Warm up

To run from one end of the room to the other slowing down and then increasing your pace.

Using a small ball or a rolled up pair of socks, can you walk and throw the object up using two hands and retrieve it from the air using two hands?

Activity

Can you practice throwing a ball up in the air using one hand and catching with two hands?

Remember to..

Keep eye contact on the ball. Don't throw higher than your chest.

Now choose your level of challenge below: Yellow – start 1m away, catch a ball dropped from shoulder height after 2 bounces

Green – react quickly and catch a tennis ball dropped from shoulder height after 1 bounce

Red – react quickly and catch a small ball dropped from shoulder height after 1 bounce, balancing on 1 leg

-dress appropriately -warm up before you carry out the task -drink plenty of water -take a rest if you need to.
