The Davie County Board of Education met at 6:00 p.m., April 13, 2021, in the Board Room of the Central Davie Education Center, 220 Martin Luther King Jr. Road, Mocksville, NC.

Vice-Chair Horne called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

David Carroll made the motion, seconded by Lori Smith, to adopt the agenda as presented. The motion carried 6-0.

Vice-Chair Horne called for a motion to go into closed session to preserve the attorney client privilege pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143-318.11(a)(3) to discuss personnel matters protected by State law and N.C.G.S.143-318.11(a)(6); to discuss student matters made confidential by N.C.G.S. 143-318.11(a)(1), G.S. 115C-402 and FERPA. Dub Potts made the motion, seconded by Paul Drechsler; the motion carried 6-0. The Board went into closed session at 5:17 p.m.

Vice-Chair Horne reconvened the meeting at 6:14 p.m. and offered the invocation then led the Pledge of Allegiance.

David Carroll made the motion, seconded by Lori Smith, to approve the minutes of the March 2, 2021 regular Board of Education meeting, March 17, 2021 specially called meeting, and the March 19, 2021 specially called meeting as presented. The motion carried 6-0.

Board Report

Vice-Chair Horne reviewed upcoming events starting with a board of education budget work session on April 21, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. On April 29, 2021, a specially called board of education meeting will take place virtually to approve the budget. The next Board of Commissioners Meeting will be Monday, May 3, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. Mrs. Horne announced the next scheduled meeting of the Board of Education will be Tuesday, May 4, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. Lastly, Davie County Early College High School graduation will take place on Saturday, May 22, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in the Davie County High School Auditorium.

Superintendent's Report

Mr. Wallace began his report saying district staff will visit with each school's staff members to thank them for their hard work during this school year. Current Davie County Schools COVID numbers as of Monday, April 12, 2021 are: Active Cases; 4 students, 0 staff members; Quarantined Cases: 8 students, 0 staff members. Mr. Wallace thanked students, parents, and staff for these low numbers in our school district. The current attendance rate for 2020-2021 Month 7 is 93.92%. For comparison, 2018-2019 Month 7 attendance rate was 94.95%. Currently, 31.8% of Davie County residents has had at least 1 vaccination; 25% of Davie County residents are fully vaccinated.

Mr. Wallace congratulated Jenni Pleasant, John Marshall, and our technology team for having Davie County Schools' new website featured on our host's, FinalSite, blog. Many words of praise were written in the blog about Davie County School's new webpage.

Mr. Wallace mentioned that for the past 3 years, Davie County Schools has worked with High Point University with the Educational Academy-Administration Courses. Currently, Davie County Schools has 2 staff members who have graduated and 1 staff member that has finished the coursework and will start an internship next school year. Davie County Schools will continue working with High Point University to prepare those wanting to become an administrator.

Mr. Wallace recognized Davie County's Mock Trial Team who won the NC State Championship. This team will compete in Nationals on May 13-15, 2021. Tani Caudle, Wendy and Terry Carlton are the team's coaches/mentors.

House Bill 82 regarding summer learning opportunity regulations was approved. The summer learning in Davie County will be in person while some instruction could be offered virtually. Davie County Schools will combine some elementary schools to house the summer learning camp, along with North Davie Middle and Davie County High School as sites as well. The requirement is 150 hours for math and reading; Davie County Schools will also include science. There will be physical education, enrichments, lunch, and transportation provided. Staff members working the summer learning sites must get a minimum of \$1,200 as a signing bonus plus their hourly rate. The summer learning camp will be paid for by COVID monies. More information will be presented once details are finalized.

Davie County Virtual School applications had a deadline of March 28, 2021. The deadline for acceptance into the school is April 19, 2021. There were a little over 200 applications for grades 4-12.

Last, Mrs. Jinda Haynes introduced the new principal of Davie County Virtual School, Valerie Feezor.

Cammie Webb made the motion to approve contracting with Honeycutt Electric as presented for the Mocksville Elementary LED Lighting Project. Dub Potts seconded the motion; the motion carried 6-0.



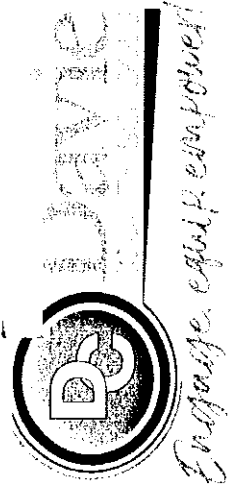
