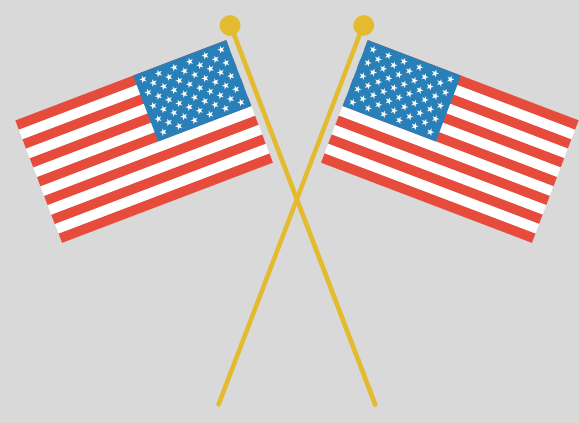

The US Dollar

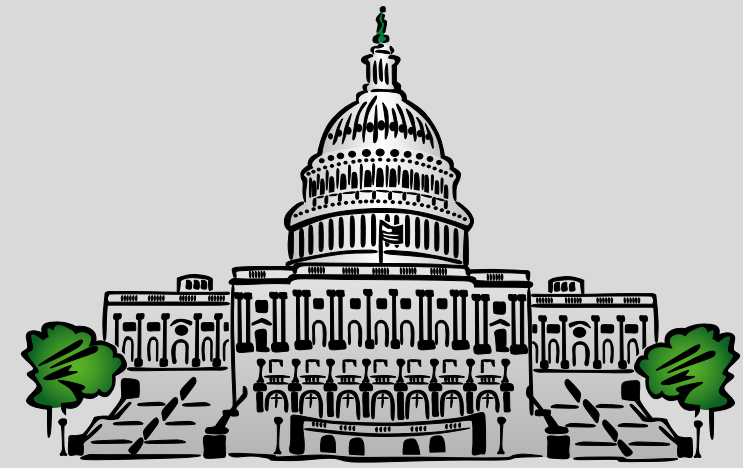

The US currency is the dollar, It comes in the denominations of 1, 5, 10, 20, 50, & 100.



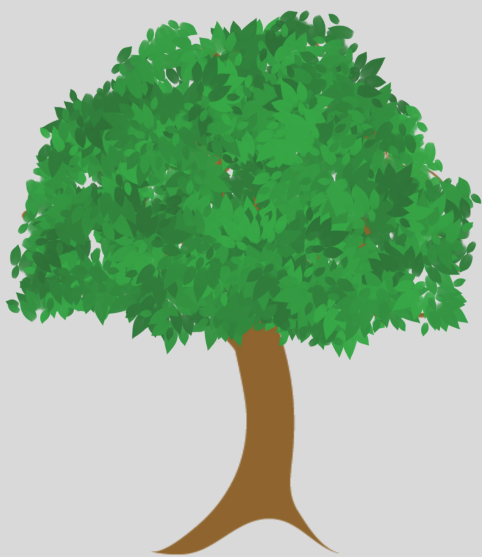
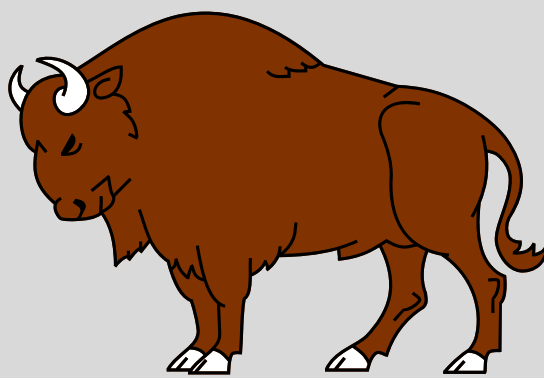
Washington DC

The District of Columbia is the capital of the USA.



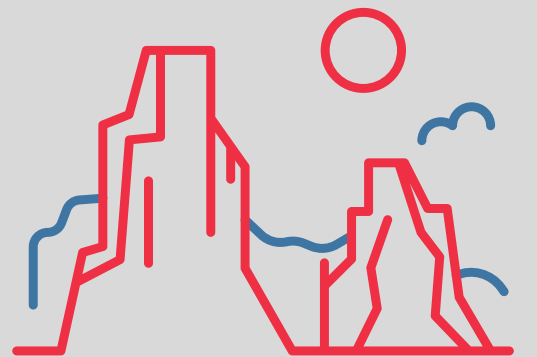
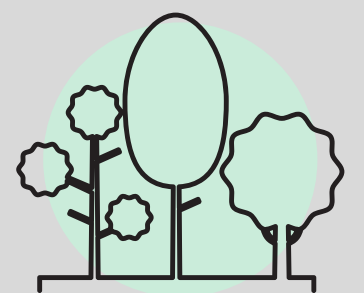
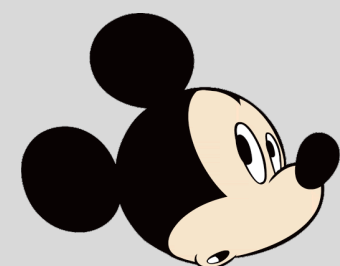
National Symbols
