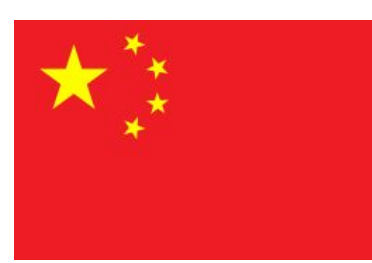

CLIMATE:

China has 4 seasons throughout the year; Summer, Winter, Spring, Autumn. Due to the vast geographical size, China's climate varies across the regions. Northern China has freezing cold winters with temperatures dropping below 0°C, and mild winters in the Southern regions. During the Summer, the whole country faces hot and wet climate, especially during June and July, when China receives direct solar radiation.

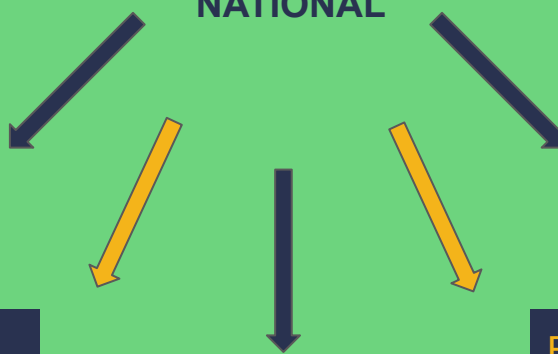

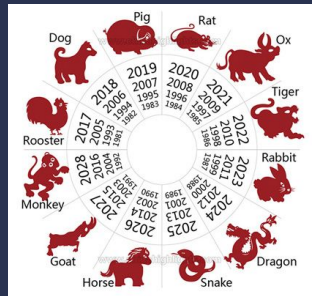
