These programmes encourage students across the world to become active, compassionate and lifelong learners who understand that other people, with their differences, can also be right.
















CAS stands for creativity, activity, service: The CAS program includes documented evidence of participating in various experiences and at least one CAS project (minimum of one month's duration) with a reasonable balance between creativity, activity, and service (150hrs).

The Extended Essay is a 4,000-word structured mini-thesis written under the supervision of an Advisor.

The ToK course involves a process of exploring and sharing students' views on "knowledge questions". The focus of the discussion should not be the differentiation between "right" and "wrong" ideas but on the quality of justification and a balanced approach to the knowledge claim in question.







GRADING SYSTEM




Students prepare for their assessments during the course of 11th and 12th grades

in May of 12th grade they sit for three weeks of examination


