Registration Dates: May 24th – June 1st

Registration forms are online or may be picked up from your student's campus.

Tuesday, June 1st -MANDATORY Summer School Registration at La Porte High School.

Transportation:

Students can sign up for 1st period, 2nd period, or both, depending on the number of credits needed to recover.

Transportation **to campus** is only available in the morning for 1st period. Transportation **from campus** is only available after 2nd period. If a student is only attending 1st period, transportation will be provided to campus, but not home. If a student is only attending 2nd period, transportation will be provided home but not to campus.

Expectation:

Instruction is face to face. Students will receive their instruction in a **blended classroom**. Course credit will be dependent upon the student completing both the Edgenuity Credit Recovery assignment and classroom participation. Face masks must be worn in the building.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS & GENERAL INFORMATION (High School)

1. High School Courses are offered for credit recovery and EOC test preparation.
2. During registration, bring this form signed and a High School Registration Form to the Mandatory Registration Day Tuesday, June 1st.
3. Students are expected to attend the summer school class(es) daily, Monday – Thursday. All district policies and procedures will be enforced. Students failing to attend the summer school class(es) daily will be dropped from the program and subsequently denied course credit.
4. Student misconduct **will not be tolerated**. Serious infractions will result in immediate removal from the program. **All students must follow the LPISD Student Code of Conduct enrolled in the Summer School.**
