School Day Preschool at Bates is open to all interested students ages 4 and up by September 1st.

***GSRP:** The Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) is a State of Michigan, grant-funded program designed to provide eligible four-year old children with high-quality preschool. Tuition funding eligibility is based on family income and school readiness risk factors. To see if you qualify, visit www.washtenawpreschool.org and fill out an online form. Families who do not qualify for funding will make payments according to the schedule below.

Payments:

- Half-day preschool payments are due every two weeks 9/1 thru 6/8 (21 payments).
- Sept-April program payments are due every two weeks 9/1 thru 4/13 (17 payments).
- May-June program payments are due every two weeks 4/27 thru 6/8 (4 payments).

Details:

- Fees include daily snacks for everyone and free lunch for school-day students through the 2021-2022 USDA Child Nutrition Program.
- Children must be potty trained to attend preschool programs.
- For school-day children, parents provide a nap/rest blanket.



Please anticipate a 2% annual increase in program tuition fees.
