# AMERICAN RED CROSS LIFEGUARD TRAINING



Brockton Community Schools and Brockton Public Schools Athletic Department are pleased to present the American Red Cross Lifeguard Training Course.

Learn the skills necessary to become a lifeguard, one of the best jobs available for young people. This is a hybrid course that will prepare and provide entry-level lifeguard participants with the knowledge and skills to prevent, recognize, and respond to aquatic emergencies, injuries, and sudden illnesses until emergency medical services (EMS) personnel arrive.

This 27-hour course includes online lessons, classroom instruction, water exercises, and practical applications in the Brockton High School swimming pool. Participants need to be proficient in basic swimming skills and have computer access. Training and certification in Lifeguarding, CPR, AED, and First Aid for the professional rescuer is included in the \$150 fee.
