Principal's Message

Dilworth Family,

As I have been out in the South parking lot by the tennis courts and working with you to get our traffic flow better, I have been very grateful to you all for your kindness, understanding, and willingness to comply with our requests. We are also very appreciative of your willingness to use the church parking lot across the street. We understand that it is a bit less convenient and requires a little more time, but we certainly have noticed a difference in the congestion on the street. We also believe it has helped to increase the safety of our students.

We are in need of four people to serve as support Para Professionals at mid-day as playground and lunch supervision. Each position will be approximately 10-12 hours per week and approximately from 11:15-1:30 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. We are also in need of five to six instructional Para Professionals to work with teachers and students in small groups.
