We want to thank all of you as you work with us to ensure the safety of your children. Whether in the parking lots, on Westminster dropping them off to use the catwalk, or walking them to school. We need four people to serve as support Para Professionals at mid-day as playground and lunch supervision. We also need five to six instructional Para Professionals to work with teachers and students in small groups. These positions would be approximately 4 to 5 hours a day Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 8:30 to about 1 or 1:30.
