The 2021 Bond for Tulsa Public Schools will further enhance the Thoreau campus with:



Refreshing the school pool, improving the practice fields, and providing equipment for the school's athletic program.

- » Upgrading the auditorium lighting and sound system and providing new stage curtains and partial seat replacement; and
- » Remodeling the school's science labs and investing in STEM equipment.

PROPOSITION 1: SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS - \$6.9 MILLION

- » Security cameras and radios
