I am on my first year of emergency certification and I am not a member of Tulsa Teacher Corps.	By May 21, 2021 Submit an updated résumé listing your teaching experience including the current school year in PDF format to your talent specialist via email.
	By June 4, 2021 You will be notified when your emergency certification renewal request has been started by the district. Please follow the instructions you will receive via email after the request has been entered to complete and submit the request. There is no fee required for second-year renewals.
I am a first-year member of Tulsa Teacher Corps.	If you have met your first-year requirements, no additional action is needed as your certificate should be valid through June 30, 2022. If this is not the case, please contact your talent strategist.
I am pursuing the bootcamp route for special education.	Contact your talent strategist.
I have already completed two years on emergency certification (all pathways).	While the Oklahoma State Department of Education may advise that additional years of emergency certification can be requested, please note that Tulsa Public Schools is not submitting emergency requests beyond the first two years. If you have not met the requirements to apply for provisional certification after your first two years on emergency certification, please contact your talent strategist to discuss next steps.
