HIGH SCHOOL LEARNING EXPERIENCE PROGRAM

The High School Learning Experience Program is designed to meet the needs of students who were unsuccessful in one or more core courses during the school year. High school students in grades 9-11 who do not earn credit in a course during the school year have the opportunity to recover credit, connect with staff and ensure a strong foundation for relationships and future learning.

Public school students enrolled in grades 9-11 during the 2020-2021 school year may attend the CCPS High School Learning Experience Program at the school in which they are enrolled.

HIGH SCHOOL LEARNING EXPERIENCE SCHEDULE

High School Learning Experience will begin on **Monday, June 14, and conclude on Thursday, July 1**. The session will be 8:00 -11:30 AM.

BLENDED REVIEW COURSES – Blended courses are offered to students who did not successfully complete a course in which they had been enrolled during the regular school year. These courses utilize a blend of online learning and face-to-face instruction. The online portion of the course uses locally approved programs of study that offer diagnostic assessments to determine students’ areas of weakness and provide targeted instruction.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Online registration forms can be found for the High School Learning Experience by visiting <https://forms.office.com/r/p7hT5Tf1MC>. Printed copies can be obtained from the school counseling office. **Registration for the High School Learning Experience begins on May 11, 2021.** Approval from the principal and a school counselor are required before registration may be completed.

Printed summer school registration forms should be submitted to the school counselor. Once approved, the counselor will forward registration forms to the lead teacher at each school.

Final class schedules are determined from the registration data. Students will be notified by the summer school office of their enrollment and the class schedule for the High School Learning Experience by June 11, 2021.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

Since the High School Learning Experience lasts for only 12 days, it is very important that participating students maintain excellent attendance. **Credit will be denied if a student misses more than one day of summer school.** Students are not excused from class for dental appointments, camp, sports, or vacations. Students who cannot attend all classes should not enroll in courses for credit. Students are also required to be on time for every class. Those who arrive late or leave early may not earn course credit.

TUITION

*A non-resident is a person who is permanently located outside Calvert County during the regular academic year.

If applicable, full tuition must be paid by June 11, 2021. Checks are to be made payable to Calvert County Public Schools. If a student withdraws from a course after attending one or more classes, **no tuition will be refunded.**

TRANSPORTATION

Calvert County Public Schools **may** provide transportation during the summer term.
