- **We went over the TSSP (Teacher Student Success Plan).**
 - Mr. Holmes has turned in a draft to the state.
- **Goals and Planned Actions**
 - Fine Arts and Awareness and Production
 - Meet the Masters.
 - We will be using the Teacher Student Success Application to help pay for this. Will not be using the TSSP funds.
 - Leadership and Social Emotional Learning (SEL)
 - We will continue Implementation of Second Steps.
 - Most of the money will be using to purchase GoGaurdian.
 - Money will also be used for the Student Council Advisors.
 - Language Arts Improvement
 - We will be looking for an increase overall end of year scores for reading proficiency to 72% in grades K-6.
 - We will be using District LA assessments for K-2nd and RISE for 3-6th grade.
 - LETRES training for teachers
 - It was discussed with getting 5 additional teaching assistance.
 - Purchase iReady Reading, Studies Weekly, Generation Genius, Newsela, and Scholastic Newsletter.
 - We want to work on raising comprehension across the school.
 - We will be purchasing books and subscriptions for classrooms to help with that.
 - Math:
 - Increase growth as measured by the RISE and District end of level/year math test by 10% over the previous year.
 - We will be using ALEKS, IXL
 - We also want to use the same 5 teacher assistance from the Language Arts section to help with math.
 - We will be using other funds to help pay for the aids.
- Community Council Approved of the TSSP plan.
- **Voting for next year's Community Council**
 - Jason Jones stating that multiple members have been on the Community Council for 2 or 3 years.

- Jason has stated that he is willing to stay on Community Council for one more year.
- Danielle Creamer has also stated that she will also stay on Community Council for next year.
