This form is intended for individuals who have received previous awards for the “Grow Our Own Teachers” Scholarship Program *in their most recent semester of college coursework*. First-time applicants or those who have taken gaps in award between semesters should not use this form.

In order to continue to qualify for the “Grow Our Own Teachers” commitment/scholarship program, applicants must:

- Continue to be enrolled in an undergraduate college/university teacher preparation program of study with a concentration in one of the following certification areas: secondary mathematics, biology, chemistry, physics, world language (French, German, Spanish), English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL), or special education.
- Have earned a 2.5 or greater GPA in the most recent semester of coursework and must continue to maintain an overall cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater.

Instructions for Application for Award for the **2022-23** Academic Year:

1. Submit this form TWICE per academic year with all supporting documents required (below) by the following deadlines. **Late applications may not be considered.***
 - **Fall 2022 Semester: August 1, 2022**
 - **Spring 2023 Semester: January 6, 2023**
2. A copy of current, cumulative college transcript(s) (unofficial is acceptable), including final grades for the most recent semester of coursework
3. A tentative class schedule for the upcoming semester
4. A tuition bill for the upcoming semester of classes

**(If circumstances dictate the unavailability of supporting documentation by the requested date, please reach out to the CTE Director prior to the due date for further discussion or direction.)*

Applicants who have successfully submitted the requested documentation will receive notification of the award via traditional mail. To avoid a delay in the scholarship award reaching the college/university, award recipients are strongly encouraged to re-apply as soon as the required information is available to be sent. Please allow a minimum of two weeks for awards to be received, processed, and mailed. Allow additional time for mail to reach the university.
