

Calvert County Public Schools "Grow Our Own Teachers" Commitment/Scholarship Program Application Form First Time Scholarship Applications Academic Year 2022-2023



This form is intended for those applying for the "Grow Our Own" Scholarship for the first time. Those who have previously been awarded should submit the renewal application.

In order to qualify for the "Grow Our Own Teachers" scholarship program, applicants must:

- Have graduated from Calvert County Public Schools on or after June 1, 2017.
- Have successfully completed the Teacher Academy of Maryland (TAM) Program at a CCPS School:
 - Earned a grade of "B" of better in all four TAM Program courses
 - Successful completion of internship experience
- Be currently enrolled in an undergraduate college/university teacher preparation program of study.
- Have completed a minimum of one semester of college coursework (at least 12 credit hours) following high school graduation with a 2.5 or greater GPA.
- Agree to provide teaching services to Calvert County Public Schools for one year for every year of scholarship awarded.
- Agree to reimburse Calvert County Public Schools for all scholarship funds received if they can not or do not satisfy all requirements of the "Grow Our Own Teachers" Commitment/Scholarship Program.
- Submit a renewal application form and updated documentation of grades and coursework for *each semester* following the initial award.

Instructions for first time applicants, complete and/or obtain and return the following:

- □ A completed Scholarship Application Form (included below)
- □ A letter of reference from your CCPS TAM teacher with initial application*
- □ A copy of your current college transcript(s) [Unofficial Transcripts are acceptable].
- Documentation of your declared college major/enrollment in one of the appropriate undergraduate programs of study (if this is included on your transcript, no further documentation is necessary).
- □ A copy of a tentative class schedule for the upcoming semester.
- □ A copy of your upcoming semester tuition bill.

(*If the TAM teacher is no longer employed with CCPS at the time of application, a school counselor, administrator's letter, or internship supervising teacher may be substituted).

Complete this form along with all requested information and return on or prior to the following dates for award for the 2022-23 Academic Year. Late applications will not be considered.

- For first-time award in Fall 2022 Semester: July 15, 2022
- For first-time award in the Spring 2023 Semester: January 6, 2023**

(**If grades/transcripts, course schedule, or tuition bill are not yet available as of this date, contact the CTE Director for assistance: application may still be accepted with appropriate communication prior to the deadline.)

- I understand that scholarship recipients who do not satisfy all requirements of the "Grow Our Own Teachers" Commitment/Scholarship Program must reimburse Calvert County Public Schools for all scholarship funds received.

 - A copy of current college transcript(s) (unofficial is acceptable), including final grades for the most recent semester of coursework
 - Documentation of declared undergraduate major
 - A class schedule for the upcoming semester of courses 0
 - A tuition bill for the upcoming semester of courses 0

- I understand late applications will not be considered for the upcoming semester. Applications are considered late if postmarked or e-mailed after the deadline dates. Deadlines for the 2022-23 Academy Award Year are July 15, 2022 and January 6, 2023.
