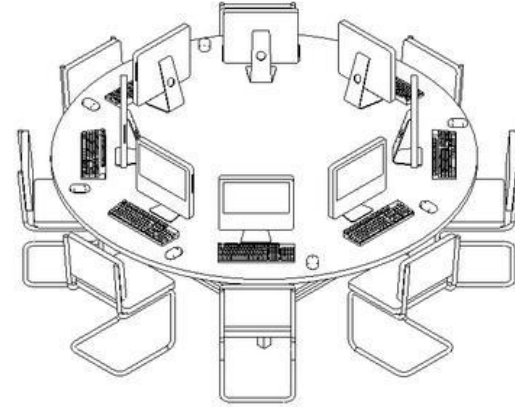
Concept/Research

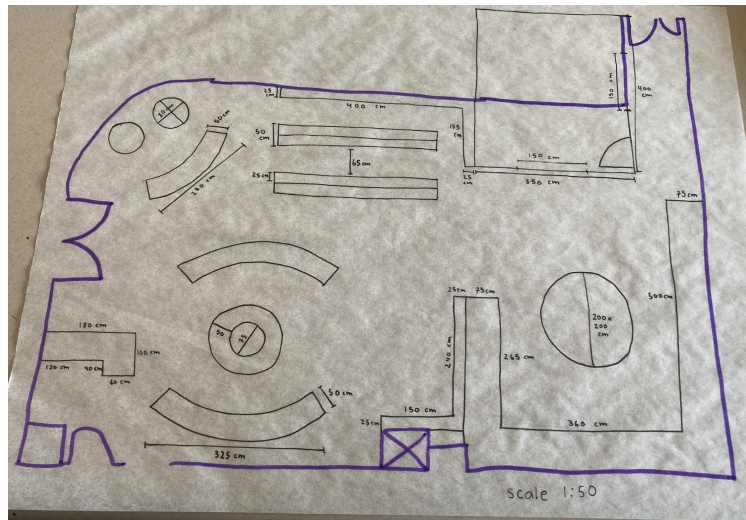

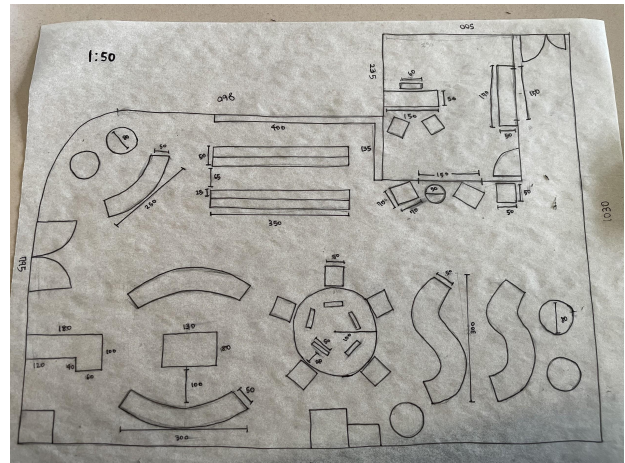
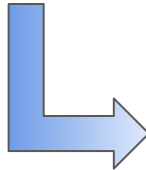

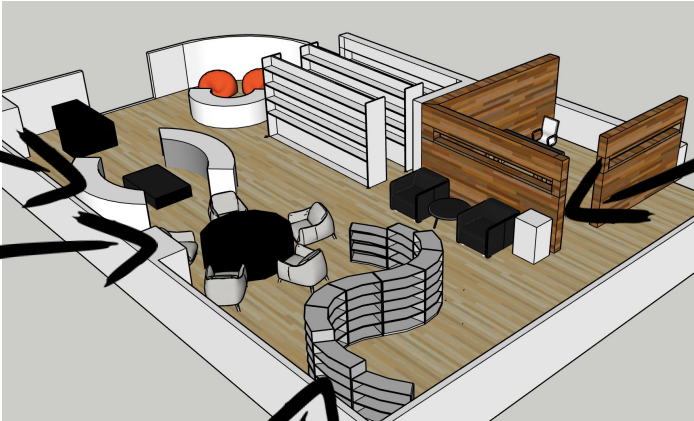

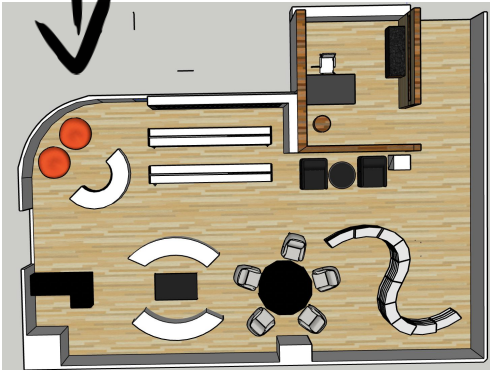

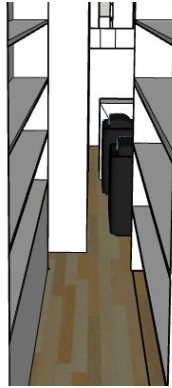

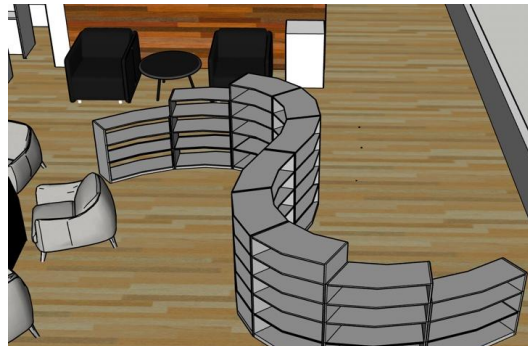


With the more open areas from the low bookshelves and the addition of the interactive table, the library will be more inviting to children, who are the main users of the library.
