

Freshman English Summer Reading
***A Dog's Purpose* By W. Bruce Cameron**

For your summer reading, read *A Dog's Purpose* by W. Bruce Cameron. This can be bought at any bookstore or ordered online. An audio version is also available.

This book takes us on a journey through four lives of a dog through reincarnation. In each life, the dog looks for his/her purpose. As you read, annotate your book for each dog's significant life events.

Your assignment after reading the book is to use the format provided to make bullet points chronicling the main events of each life. **For each life**, begin by including the name of the dog, whether the dog is male or female, and the breed of the dog. Then list 5-10 bullet points telling the main events in each life. These should be in complete sentences. Conclude with the purpose of each dog's life.

This is to be typed using a readable font using double space. Include a heading and title for your assignment. Below is the format to follow in setting up your document and filling in the details of each of the four dog's lives. This assignment will be turned in to your English teacher typed and printed on the first day of school.
