As you are aware, the Suffield Public Schools have worked in partnership with Hartford HealthCare to provide vaccination clinics for district employees and age-eligible students. Over the past week, the district has been in communication with representatives from Hartford HealthCare in hopes of being able to extend vaccination opportunities to younger students who are now age-eligible according to federal and state guidance.
