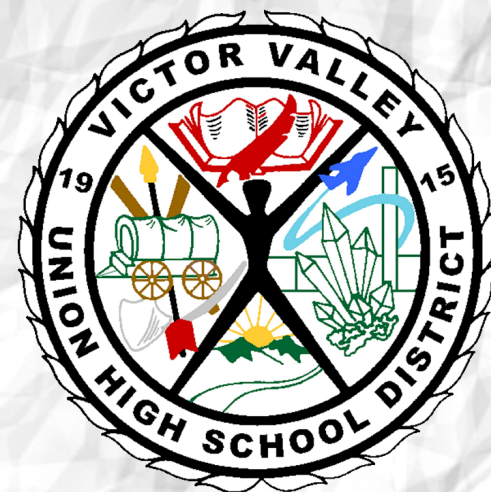

Online Only Credit Recovery

APEX or Acellus courses offered to grades 9-12 at AHS, SHS, and VVHS.

APEX credit recovery: Reduced curriculum. Student has taken and failed a course offered in APEX - highest grade earned is C. **Acellus:** Full curriculum. In Acellus, student has taken and failed a course offered - May earn a grade up to an A. In Acellus, student may take course for original credit with district approval if student is credit deficient and an incoming 12th grader.
