- Election of Chair/Co-Chair – The Elected Chair is Jenni Micheletti and the cochair is Josiah Helbling
- HB58 – Part of the PBIS program must include Alcohol and Tobacco with an emphasis on Vaping. PPT shared on what we are doing which includes the Second Steps program. What we could add- teaching about who to go to and where the “safe spaces” are/ Nurse teaching the facts to the older students
- PBIS – In addition to the above mentioned items, we are sending positive letters, certificates, and postcards home
- Calendar -
  - ✓ Mid-Term – SEPs (Parent Teacher Conferences) will be held November 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>. Teachers have the option of in person or on Zoom. Most will likely be on Zoom. First Trimester ends November 20<sup>th</sup>. FYI- the second SEPs are scheduled for February 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>. Back to School Event – “Pass out Popsicles” Drive-by event on Tuesday, October 13<sup>th</sup> from 3-5.
  - ✓ Halloween – Drive-by car parade and trick or treat event during the regular lunch time of 10:30-12:30.
  - Remote Learning – Currently M, T, TH, & F are live Zoom classes, with W for small group or independent work. Right now, only ELLs and SPED are allowed in person for small group instruction, no more than 5 students at a time. The district is considering small groups in K-2.
  - ✓ Feedback- Successes – seems to be going smoothly for many parents and students/Concerns – working parents must catch-up with students every

evening (not school's fault, just what it is.) Some class work seems too much for one assignment (upper grades.) Worry that kids whose parents are not able to help them are falling farther behind. Suggestion: small community parent groups help each other out, several parents willing to do this

- **Smart Goals** – high expectations, responding effectively to needs, and providing a safe environment: 30% of ELLs will meet Path of Progress/Instructional Goals in Reading, Improve Attendance
- **School Success Plan (SSP)** – Closing achievement gap for Black/African American, ELL, and SPED students by 35%
- **Land Trust** – Changed our Language Arts focus from Writing to Reading with an emphasis on ELLs/AVID strategies, specifically WICOR (Writing, Inquiry, Collaboration, Organization, and Reading) schoolwide. Land trust money is approximately \$32,000.
- **Schedule Monthly Meeting** – 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the month @ 3:30 p.m. However, due to Thanksgiving, November's meeting will be on the 18<sup>th</sup>. On the next agenda- the school emergency plan
