

Summer Program Policies

In-Person Sports Camps 2021

Any students that are attending a Summer Program in person will follow all Covid protocols that the district currently has in place. Sports Camps will have their own set of guidelines depending on the sport and location of the camp. All in-person sessions will only run during the morning hours, there will be no lunch or afternoon sessions in-person.

LATE PICK-UPS

Please remember all children need to be picked up on time! Students must picked up at the appropriate time for their program. Students are not permitted to wait unattended for another student in a different program offered at the school. Therefore, parents are responsible for picking up their children on time, even if arrangements are made through carpooling. Two (2) late pick-ups may result in your child being dismissed from the program without a refund.

VIDEOTAPING

Edison School Network (ESN-118) may visit our Sports Camps to videotape our activities. Highlights from these programs program may be shown on Channel 118 or used on the district website. If you have an objection to your child being videotaped, please write a note to the Summer Programs office and give it to your child's Enrichment/Activities teacher or sports coach.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Please be aware that summer construction projects may be taking place on school grounds, which could result in noise and smells. We make every effort to minimize student exposure. In addition, buildings are not air-conditioned, so please make sure that students are appropriately dressed.

Remote SUMMER PROGRAMS 2021

During these challenging times, the Edison Township Board of Education is thrilled that we can offer summer programs remotely for the youth of Edison Township. We are offering programs for Edison students in grades 1 through 12. These programs are designed for students who have transitioned well to Remote Learning and enjoy self-directed learning, exploration and are actively engaged in their learning. These courses are designed as enrichment classes and sports camps that will help children develop certain skills, but they are not strictly aligned to the curriculum the students are engaged in during the school year. Children will not be graded or formally assessed during these summer programs, however they will receive feedback from their instructors throughout the program.

<u>Devices:</u> The students will be permitted to use their district issued devices for the summer programs. Remember that the same technology policies are in effect for the summer regarding care of the device and ensuring that it is used for school-related use only. Please note that students will be using their district emails for the remote programs.

Please make sure to read the course/camp descriptions carefully before selecting courses with your children. Some programs will require you to purchase materials or have access to certain sports equipment or instruments in order to participate in the course.

Summer Program Policies

<u>Scheduling</u>

The Summer Programs Administrative Staff reserves the right to limit the enrollment of each class/program/camp on a first enrolled basis. Registering as soon as possible is recommended to assure a place in the class/camp you want and to protect against cancellation due to insufficient enrollment. Once the programs begin, there will not be an opportunity to change courses/camps due to the limited enrollment opportunities.

COVID Protocols

The in-person Sports Camps will follow all current CDC and district guidelines during this time.

COVID-19 protocols will be followed at all times according to CDC guidelines and are subject to change. There will be temperature checks upon arrival. If your child tests positive for COVID-19, a refund will NOT be issued. If your child has to be quarantined due to another camper who tests positive, you will receive a prorated refund.

CONFIRMATION POLICY

<u>Summer Enrichment:</u> When you register online you will receive confirmation immediately that your registration was successful. We will contact you by phone ONLY if an Enrichment class is full or cancelled. We will work with you to reschedule another class. Your child will receive his or her Enrichment class schedule via email.

<u>Sports Camp:</u> When you register online, you will receive confirmation immediately that your registration was successful. If a sports camp is cancelled due to lack of participation, we will attempt to give you 5 days notice of the cancellation.

REFUND POLICY

All tuition fees include a non-refundable \$30.00 registration fee.

Since classes/camps are approved based on a sufficient number of paid registrations, fees will not be returned for any reason after the class/camp has started. The Summer Programs Administrative staff reserves the right to cancel any class/camp in which registration is insufficient. A full refund will be issued, or you may transfer to another class/camp that is still available.

<u>All refund requests must be in writing</u> and received via the <u>summer.programs@edison.k12.nj.us</u> no later than Friday, July 16th, 2021. All refunds will be <u>processed after August 20th</u>, 2021, and sent by mail from the Business Office of the Board of Education.

RECEIPTS

If you require a receipt (besides your online confirmation), you **must put your request in writing** and send it to the Edison Public Schools - ATTN: Summer Programs, 312 Pierson Avenue, Edison, NJ 08837 or emailed to summerprograms@edison.k12.nj.us. **All requests must be received before August 31, 2021 so that we may verify your child's attendance. All receipts will be issued by September 30, 2021.**

INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR POLICY

For the safety and enjoyment of all summer program participants, any inappropriate behavior by Activities/Enrichment/Sports Camp students may result in dismissal from the program. No refunds will be issued if your child is dismissed for inappropriate behavior. All district technology agreements must be followed throughout the Summer Program.

All Summer Program registrations will not be complete until the required Code of Conduct is signed by a parent.



The Summer Activities Program is for children who completed kindergarten or first grade in the 2020-2021 school year. The Summer Activities Program is designed to engage learners in fun activities that enhance their academic, physical, and social skills. They will be given the opportunity to create various crafts (all different over the four weeks) and play a variety of games (sports, math, etc.). Reading and writing activities will also be integrated into the program. Certified teachers will be conducting and overseeing all facets of the remote program.

We are offering three one hour sessions each day from 9-12 for the the of length 19 day summer program. There will be another session offered each day from 12:30-2 in the afternoon. In these sessions, students will be exposed to children's literature that has cross-curricular connections. Students will enjoy a read aloud and discussion of a story, followed by math, language, and physical activities related to the story or the theme in the story. The students will be interacting with their teachers and classmates on Google Meet or Zoom throughout the hour class.

SUMMER ENRICHMENT Program 2021

GRADES 3 - 8



All REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ONLINE!

The Enrichment Program offers academic refresher classes, such as math improvement, creative writing and book clubs, as well as enrichment classes, such as drama, dance, journalism, music, exploring science and technology.

ALL ENRICHMENT CLASSES ARE BEING HELD REMOTELY FROM June 28, 2021 TO July 23, 2021, with no programs or activities held on July 5. The structure for the Enrichment classes may include a mix of "live" sessions with the teacher and classmates using Google Meets or Zoom, recorded lessons, and independent work time for the students throughout the class.

Students may select up to 3 one-hour courses for the morning and 1 class in the afternoon (please check the schedule that is listed after course descriptions).

One-Hour Classes that do not require the purchase of materials \$95.00 per class
One-Hour Classes that require the purchase of materials \$80.00 per class
One & Half Hour Classes that do not require the purchase of materials \$145.00 per class
One and a Hour Classes that require the purchase of materials \$130.00 per class

The Enrichment Program is a 19-day program. All classes run from June 28th - July 23, 2021.

The fees cover the entire 19-day program.

ART ENRICHMENT



Cartooning



Remote 1 Hour Grades 3-8 Fee: \$80

This class is for students who are interested in learning how to create cartoon images. Participants will explore existing cartoons, as well as create their own original ones.

Course Materials Needed:

Ruler (or any straight-edge), Sharpies (black, extra-fine and fine), Any white drawing paper(no lines), Post-it notes for a flip-book, Colored markers, Colored pencils Pencil/eraser/sharpener, Play-Doh or make-your-own salt dough

Textile Art



Remote
1.5 Hours

Grades 3-8 Fee: \$130

Students will explore the use of a variety of textiles such as felt, yarn, string, burlap and more in an artistic fashion. Students will learn simple weaving, hand sewing, applique and fabric design techniques in this fun and relaxing class.

Course Materials Needed:

Scissors(Fiskars is a good brand for material cutting) Elmer's white glue or tacky glue, Some yarn (a variety of colors as needed)
Sewing kit (Dollar Tree, Walmart, Amazon) or sewing loose supplies (your sewing kit should include sewing needles/ pins/ needle threader/ some thread)
Various colors of felt or material (can be from recycled clothes) Small beads/ buttons as needed/wanted Various colors of embroidery floss- 3 to 5

Drawing/Painting



Remote 1 Hour Grades 3-8

Fee: \$80

Do you love to draw and paint? We will show you how to use a variety of art mediums to make amazing art in this 1 hour course. You will learn not only how to take care of your supplies but also techniques that will improve your skills and excite your creative mind. Since the course is remote this year, there will be a virtual art show to share everyone's favorite pieces.

Course Materials Needed:

Watercolors (Crayola, Prang sets comes with a brush) Acrylic paint set (any brand), Liquid Glue (elmer's white glue), Colored pencils, Colored markers, Crayons, Oil Pastels, Sharpies (Black extra-fine, and fine) Scissors/regular pencil/ eraser

Drawing Paper/ copy paper/sketch pad (no lines on it), Watercolor paper pad (XL - Canson 9x12 size or bigger)

Painting with the Masters



Remote 1 Hour Grades 4-8 Fee: \$80

Did you ever want to paint like Van Gogh without losing an ear? Or see the desert through the eyes of Georgia O'keeffe? What was Jean-Michel Basquiat trying to say with his graffiti art? In each class you will be introduced to a new artist! You will take a virtual walk in their shoes, learn fun facts, see their art THEN MAKE ART in that artist's style. We will be painting our summer away!!

Course Materials Needed:

Suggested supplies- Acrylic and watercolor paint. (tempera paint is fine for some projects too) xl brand watercolor paper pad (9x12) can be found in Walmart or you may also paint on canvas or canvas board (keep it on the small side though - under 14 inches.) A variety of artist paint brushes and a water container.

3D Design



Remote 1 Hour Grades 4-8 Fee: \$80

This course brings everything you love about ceramics and will incorporate other forms of 3 dimensional art. Young artists will plan and create sculpture out of a variety of materials and display their creations during our virtual art show. Course Materials Needed:

toilet paper/paper towel rolls, cardboard (cereal boxes) , good scissors, liquid glue, magazines, plastic bottles, twine, duct tape

Fashion Design



Remote
1.5 Hours

Grades 5-8

Fee: \$130

This class is designed for students with a passion for fashion! Students will explore the art of fashion design by using hands-on techniques not only how to design their own clothing and accessories, but they will also learn the art of coordinating outfits in order to complete their ideal "look".

LANGUAGE ARTS ENRICHMENT



Readers Club



Remote 1 Hour Grades

Fee: \$80

A class where students will LOVE reading! This course allows students to join a book group and read the same book. Students will spend time reading a novel together and discussing it. They will also engage in weekly book talks, literature circle discussions, book celebrations and write like the author days. Research shows that choice and comfort really help kids appreciate a love of reading let the reading journey begin!

Materials List

Creative Writing



Remote 1 Hour Grades 3-8 Fee: \$95

A fun, interactive class to help young writers unlock their creativity, improve their craft, and write better stories! Young writers will learn the essential ingredients of great fiction, so they can improve their writing, tell better stories, write more vivid scenes, and build confidence in their writing abilities. The class will help young writers (beginner to advanced) build a storytelling foundation and nurture their love of writing. Create awesome characters who will jump right off the page and take your stories to the next level. Develop exciting plots that will keep your stories on track and have your readers on the edge of their seats to find out what happens next!

Journalism



Remote 1 Hour

Grades 3-6 Fee: \$95

Students will examine the newspaper to learn about its different components. With the knowledge they gain about news articles, feature stories, editorials and other newspaper parts, the students will work as part of a "news team" to create a newspaper of their own.

Journey Through the Genres



Remote 1 Hour Grades 3-8 Fee: \$95

The learner will become familiar with various genres of writing including Narrative Writing, Expository Writing, Persuasive Writing, and Descriptive Writing. The learner will use the writing process to explore all of these genres in creative ways. Students will read and analyze different types of writing. The students will then be taught how to use the writing process to publish writing in all of these genres. Students will present their writing to the class in creative ways and learn how to tackle different genres in the classroom.

Word Play



Remote 1 Hour

Grades 3-8 Fee: \$95

This remote class offers students the opportunity to explore the English language! Each day, students will receive a word of the day to add to their journals (please have a notebook prepared), as well as have time to explore through various activities - word ladders, games, videos, etc. The class teacher will hold daily virtual meetings to discuss the new content and explain the day's activities. Students will have a chance to play word-play games virtually with their peers as well. Access to a printer is helpful, but not necessary. Let's play!

Catch the Podcasting Bug



Remote 1 Hour

Grades 4-8 Fee: \$95

The learner will become familiar with various genres of writing including Narrative Writing, Expository Writing, Persuasive Writing, and Descriptive Writing. The learner will use the writing process to explore all of these genres in creative ways. Students will read and analyze different types of writing. The students will then be taught how to use the writing process to publish writing in all of these genres. Students will present their writing to the class in creative ways and learn how to tackle different genres in the classroom.

Wizarding World of Harry Potter



Remote 1.5 Hours

Grades 4-8 Fee: \$145

Calling all witches and wizards! In this class, students will explore the world of Harry Potter through crafts, games, writing, and online activities. This class is ideal for any Harry Potter lover- whether they are new to the world of Hogwarts or if they have seen every movie and read all the books!





Math Improvement



Remote 1 Hour Grades 3-8 Fee: \$95

The main focus of this class is to improve math skills, as well as challenge the students with upcoming mathematical concepts. In order to meet the needs of all students, instruction will be varied and allow for opportunities for group problem solving and independent practice. Due to the popularity of this class, classes will be based on grade levels (3-4, 5-6 and 7-8).

Geometry & Creative Writing through Origami

Remote
1.5 Hours

Grades 4-8 Fee: \$130

This remote class offers a creative and enjoyable way to explore the exciting world of geometry and creative writing. Through simple origami folding techniques and construction, students will examine mathematical concepts such as two-and three-dimensional shapes, patterns, puzzles, angles, perimeter, area, symmetry and tessellations. Teachers will post instructional videos at the beginning of each class, and students will have time to explore and practice. Once students have completed their origami pieces, they will have the opportunity to write a story, dialogue or create mini-movies about their creations and will showcase their work to the class.

Course Materials Needed:

Escape Room



Remote 1 Hour Grades 3-8 Fee: \$95

Who? What? When? Where? Why? Follow the clues to solve the mystery. Any good detective has a team behind him/her and helps to solve the problem. In this course, students will be faced with many challenges that need a team virtually to crack. Due to the popularity of this class, classes will be based on grade levels (3-4, 5-6 and 7-8).

Brain Games



Remote
1.5 Hours

Grades 3-8 Fee: \$145

This class is perfect for students who want to sharpen their critical thinking skills, think in flexible ways, and work collaboratively with their peers. Throughout the course students will work through different types of puzzles such as riddles, logic puzzles, brain teasers and more. Not only will students work together to solve puzzles, they will have opportunities to create their own.

Strategize



Remote 1 Hour Grades 3-6 Fee: \$95

This class is designed for students who love to play games and want to understand some strategies to increase their chances of winning. The students will learn to explore the logic and strategies behind common board games and card games while having fun with their peers. Students will need a deck of cards for this class.

Lego Challenge



Remote 1 Hour Grades 3-8 Fee: \$80

What can happen when imagination, creativity, and math come together with Legos? Amazing engineering feats through daily building challenges. Students will be able to put those important math practice skills such as problem solving, perseverance, precision, modeling, and critiquing into practice as they tackle daily Lego challenges using basic pieces. Participants will need to have access to basic Lego pieces. A link with a suggested set is below.

SCIENCE ENRICHMENT



Experimenting with Science



Remote 1 Hour Grades 3-8 Fee: \$80

Experimenting with Science Remote Learning will be a combination of hands-on and virtual activities. Between STEM challenges, brain teasers, online lessons, at home experiments, and virtual labs this course offers a fun and engaging virtual approach to Science. Many of the materials needed are common household items.

Activities and Materials List

Forensic Explorations



Remote 1 Hour Grades 4-8 Fee: \$80

The learner will become familiar with the various methods utilized in forensic science to solve crimes through math, science, and technology. Students will learn about the history of forensic science, how to classify fingerprints, apply techniques like chromatography, blood spatter analysis, and dental impressions, reconstruct a crime scene, and solve a murder mystery. Due to the popularity of this class, classes will be based on grade levels (4-5, 6, and 7-8). Due to the on-line nature of this course, some materials must be provided by the student/parent. A list of materials needed will be emailed after registration. There will also be a separate "pick-up packet" of materials provided.

Activity & Materials List

Small Team Building for Creative Problem Solving



Remote 1 Hour

Grades 3-8 Fee: \$95

This course will be dedicated to fostering the skills necessary for succeeding as a competitive small group or team among your peers (for example such as an OM team or classroom small group) from Grades 3-8. Students will be placed in groups of 4-8 members and introduced to the basic skills needed for success in and out of the classroom for anyone on a team, interested in starting a team, or just interested in a creative problem solving experience and building those related skills. Members will learn to Apply their own Creativity, Stretch their mind to become more nimble in verbal and hands-on problems. Learn New skills in Basic Woodworking and Fastening, for Engineering Structures and Vehicles creating props or performance items that will help you be successful in earning grades, completing group challenges, or competing against peer groups. This course will be taught by an executive board member of New Jersey Odyssey of the Mind and 18 yr veteran Edison OM Coach.

<u>Materials List</u>

Spaghetti Architect



Remote
1.5 Hours

Grades 5-8 Fee: \$130

This is a course in structure engineering that uses dried spaghetti and glue as its primary building material. Students will explore the basic engineering design procedure and the physics of dynamics and energy. They will study, build, and test towers, bridges, and similar structures accounting for environmental conditions such as Hurricanes, Tornadoes, and/or Earthquakes. Participants will need to have uncooked spaghetti and glue.

<u>Materials List</u>

Physics of Toy Design



Remote 1 Hour

Grades 3-8 Fee: \$95

This course looks at the physics needed for toys. Not just the playthings of children, these devices are modern technological wonders in physics and chemistry just as they are ancient applications of simple machines. It looks at how toys throughout the last 2 millennium used and still use simple materials along with complex science to captivate children's attention, inspire their imagination, and construct their foundations for vocational potential.

SOCIAL STUDIES ENRICHMENT



Who's Who in History



Remote 1 Hour Grades

Fee: \$95

Each session we will be exploring another influential person that has made the world a better place. We will be introduced to the "Who's Who" through videos, literature, speeches and much more! Can you guess who we will be studying?

Speaking Skills



Remote 1 Hour Grades 3-8

Fee: \$95

Speaking in public is a skill that everyone should master! Through various activities, students will learn skills and techniques to help make them better public speakers. They will witness how body language, facial expressions, tone of voice, volume of speech and eye contact can add to or detract from the content of their speeches. The students create, then deliver, speeches on a variety of topics.

The Great Debate



Remote
1.5 Hours

Grades 6-8 Fee: \$145

This course, designed for grades 6-8, will allow students to discover the many facets of debate. Students will learn about and practice impromptu debate as well as interpretation speaking, which helps students to focus on verbal and nonverbal delivery in playful and fun ways. The students will also learn the basics of debate by deciding on current, relevant issues as a group and by researching and preparing cases as a team.

Monsters in Mythology & Legends



Remote 1.5 Hours

Grades 3-8 Fee: \$145

Have you ever heard of the Tengu of Japan? How about the Celtic Dullahan? Each week we will explore the bizarre and unexplained myths and legends of continents across the world. Students will read age-appropriate stories, play culturally themed games, learn about monster holidays and create projects based on each legend.

Elementary Student Leadership



Remote
1.5 Hours

Grades 3-5 Fee: \$145

What does it mean to be a leader? How can I improve my leadership skills? This class is designed to increase confidence through the introduction of essential leadership skills. The course will teach students how to apply important leadership skills such as problem-solving, critical thinking, team building and more that they can bring back to the classroom in September.

Around the World in 19 Days



Remote
1.5 Hours

Grades 3-8 Fee: \$145

Students will "travel" around the world to explore land features, art, music, food, and cultures. With the help of today's streaming platforms, we will explore the land, "join in" festivals, and be one with the wildlife. Google Art & Culture will allow the kids to take virtual trips to the actual museums and be able to "walk" through the exhibits themselves in their current state! We will also participate in hands-on activities such as art projects and create presentations to share our knowledge with the class. Come join us on this once in a lifetime trip around the world!

MUSIC ENRICHMENT



Introduction to Piano



Remote 1 Hour

Grades 3-8

Fee: \$95

This course is for students who have no prior experience playing piano. Students will receive individual lessons as well as group instruction, as they learn the fundamentals of reading music and proper performance technique.

*Students must have access to a piano or keyboard at home.

Composer's Workshop



Remote 1.5 Hours Grades 3-8

Fee: \$145

This course offers an introduction to music writing for both singers and instrumentalists. Subjects will include lyric writing, improvisation and arrangement and electronic music. Students will learn to compose in various styles. Students must be able to read music and have at least one year of experience playing an instrument or singing in chorus. Piano ability is helpful, but not required.

Beginner Band



Remote 1 Hour

Grades 3-8

Fee: \$95

In this class, students will learn the basics of how to play band (woodwinds and brass) instruments (flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, euphonium). They will learn basic music reading notation. This is ideal for those students that want to take band class, but who missed out on it in elementary school or middle school. It's also a great refresher for a student that may have taken time off in band. Students are required to have a working instrument for the start of classes. They also need Essential Elements, Book 1.

Band



Remote 1 Hour

Grades 5-8

Fee: \$95

This course is not for beginner students. It is for students in grades 4-8 who have had at least one year of instruction. Students will be grouped according to ability and will be given ensemble and small group instruction, where applicable. Daily rehearsals will be conducted with the intent of fostering further technique and musicality building upon previous experience. Course guideline is contingent upon enrollment and instrumentation. There will be a different class for grades 5 & 6 and then grades 7 & 8.

Beginner Guitar

(vounger students or students with no musical experience)

(older students and/or prior music experience)

This is the course for you. Although an overview will cover the basics of guitar, this course is geared towards learning at a faster pace. We will cover the more advanced techniques mentioned above to enhance your skills. Even if you have never played guitar, but have some musical experience, this is the course for you. You will need your own instrument prior to the first class. Recommended places to get a guitar are Sam Ash and Music & Arts in town. Both acoustic and electric guitars will work. Daily worksheets and instructional videos will be provided via Google Classroom. Stay tuned for 'Tuning Hours', week before classes.

Beginner Orchestra (younger students or students with no musical experience)



Remote 1 Hour

Grades 4-8 Fee: \$95

Have you always wanted to learn violin, viola, cello or bass, but don't know where to start? Perhaps you missed the sign up at your school and want to try it out in the summer. This course is for you. You will learn the basics of music, how to read music, how stringed instruments work, with step by step daily instruction on how to play. You will learn songs such as Twinkle, Mary Had a Little Lamb, Baby Shark, We Will Rock You, Jana Gana Mana and others!
