THE 9-12 ENRICHMENT PROGRAM COURSE OFFERINGS

Teacher Recommendation - Free tuition for current Stafford MSD students.
Optional – Tuition \$25 for currently enrolled SMSD Students

THE 9-12 ENRICHMENT CREDIT RECOVERY PROGRAM COURSE OFFERINGS

The Credit Recovery Program allows students to regain credit for previously failed courses by successfully completing coursework. Credit Recovery registration must be approved by the student's school counselor. Free tuition for currently enrolled Stafford MSD students only. Tuition for out-of-district students is \$150 per course.

ORIGINAL CREDIT COURSEWORK IS AVAILABLE FOR PROFESSIONAL COMMUNICATIONS.

This course is fee based and will be available for rising 9-12th grade students in good standing. The cost of this course is \$75 for currently enrolled Stafford MSD students only and \$175 for out-of-district students.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES

Students are only allowed two absences. After the second absence they are withdrawn from summer school. Efficient use of class time is essential to the student's success. Refunds will not be given to students who are withdrawn for lack of engagement or progress in coursework.

DRESS CODE

All students attending summer school in SMSD are required to follow their campus SMSD dress code and grooming policies. Students receiving a second (2nd) warning will be withdrawn from summer school without receiving a grade for the session regardless of the date within the session on which the incident occurs. Refunds will not be given to students who are withdrawn for dress and grooming violations. Students in grades PK-8 are required to wear the SMSD uniform.

IMPORTANT NOTES

Student athletes who may be pursuing NCAA, NAIA, or NJCAA eligibility should be aware that coursework completed via online learning may not meet program requirements. Please ensure you verify eligibility of course(s) with your counselor. **Original Credit Course** (counselor's permission required) are for students who are taking the course for the first time or students who are repeating a course due to excessive absences or denied credit.

DISCIPLINE GUIDELINES

All students will follow the SMSD Student Code of Conduct. Students refusing to adhere to the code of conduct who receive a second (2nd) discipline referral will be withdrawn from summer school without receiving a grade for the session regardless of the date within the session. This action will be taken without receipt of a grade/credit for the session regardless of the date within the session on which the incident occurs. Refunds will not be given to students who are withdrawn for discipline reasons.

REFUND PROCEDURES

Students who are withdrawn from summer school for disciplinary reasons, or who are withdrawn because of lack of engagement and course progress, will not receive any refund for fees paid on behalf of the student. Refunds will not be given once classes begin on the first day of summer school session, June 16, 2021. There are NO cash payments allowed. Payments may be made online with credit/debit card. All allowable requests for refunds must be made in writing to the summer school principal. A \$25 processing fee will be deducted from each approved refund. Refunds will be given due to the cancellation of classes and will not be subject to a processing fee. Please Allow up to 4 weeks processing time.
