

Reminders for ARA Students & Parents



In order to keep the learning environment safe and ensure the success of every learner, please use these reminders to practice good cyber etiquette.

Students:

- Be dressed and groomed in a manner that is appropriate for a classroom.
- Turn off your video if you need to do something you don't want others to see.
- Set up a location with minimal distractions (school appropriate virtual backgrounds).
- Be on time. Class starts at the scheduled meeting time. Allow yourself a few minutes to set up your work space, supplies, audio/video, etc.
- Be respectful of the learning process. Holding up any items, signs, or pictures that are not necessary for the lesson is unacceptable.

Parents:

- Be dressed and groomed in a manner that is appropriate for a classroom if you pass by your student's device during a live lesson.
- Turn off your child's video if you need to do something you don't want others to see.
- Be respectful of the learning process by not interrupting the teacher during a live lesson.
- Do not engage in the use of controlled substances, alcohol or tobacco products on camera. District staff are mandated reporters.
