Leslie Boeckel – Eat N Earn and 8th Grade Promotion

- March eat and earn at Jersey Mikes; donated 15% of receipts
 - We will receive \$124 donation!
- Upcoming eat and earn at McDonalds
 - Thursday April 15th from 1-7 PM at the McDonalds across from Churchville
 - Supporting Emerson, Churchville, and Conrad Fisher
 - There will also be a plastic jar at second window and schools get 100% of those tips and you will get a cookie!
- 8th grade promotion
 - Last day for 8th graders is Thursday, May 27
 - That afternoon (specific times TBD), special ceremony at all three middle schools
 - Churchville is holding promotion ceremony rain or shine on this day
 - Committee is working hard to make it special and everything our students deserve
 - Also ordering yard signs for all students
 - Planning committee needs some funds for:
 - 161 graduation yard signs \$1,119
 - Flowers and balloons \$800
 - Total needed (minus \$200 already in budget for this event) is \$1,800
 - These funds will be moved to the 8th grade promotion line item

- So far, 2 boxes have been ordered
- For parents with a lot of leftover supplies, there is another option to buy a full or re-stock box; less expensive (for 7th and 8th graders); 6th graders can only get a full box
- We get \$4 per box donated
- Boxes will be delivered straight to students' homes

Fundraising – Darren Morton

- Tri-middle school trivia night
- 21 teams
- 576 split the pot tickets (about 25% came after the night started); total price was \$1,400 and was split between winners
- Also a hivehouse gift certificate
- \$400 raised through restaurants
- Expenses were \$135 and we raised \$1,427
