Grades Y5-5 continued 5-day in-person instruction, and grades 9-12 continued 4 days in-person instruction with Wednesday remote virtual instruction. Grades 6-8 began Wednesday remote instruction on April 28 with the remaining 4 days in-person. Remote virtual learning options continue to operate for grades Y5-12 for students and families choosing that option.
