




Reporting a Positive COVID Case

- Families must report positive case in their household to their teacher, principal or school nurse
- School nurse will follow up with the student/family for symptom and contact information
- Student or staff who has been exposed will be contacted by the school

COVID Testing

- COVID testing is available to staff and students
- Of staff and students who have accessed testing, the results have shown no transmission
- Expansion to COVID monitor testing beginning Fall 2021


Safety Measures

- Refining plans and training as guidance evolves
 - Elementary schools added meal protocols
- Daily health screening
- Mandatory masks
- Physical Distancing
 - Students maintain 3 feet distance (except while eating).
 - Adults continue to maintain 6 feet distance.
- Contact tracing and quarantining

Transportation Plan

We will follow these safety practices on school buses:

- Masks are required

Preschool and Elementary (K-5) Remote Learning

For 2021-22 School Year:

- *Live online* instruction five days a week
 - (Preschool is four days a week)
- Access to dual language instruction, highly capable and special education services
- Access to music and PE instruction
- Students will be assigned to a remote classroom at their grade-level with students from other schools. The teacher may not be from your child's current school
- Families are asked to commit to online learning for the full year



Preschool and Elementary (K-5) Options for 2022-23

For the 2022-23 school year:

- Students will **return to the school where they were enrolled for the 2020-21 school year** for in-person instruction
- **Rising Kindergarten students** will be enrolled in their neighborhood school for in-person instruction
- **Students entering 6th grade in 2022-23** will be enrolled in the middle school in their service area or can apply to a choice school
- **Students entering grades 4, 5, or 6 in 2022-23** can apply to Highline Virtual Academy

Student Experience

- Commit to independent learning that is self-paced
- Complete all assignments on an online learning platform
- Engage in small group or individual learning support as needed with teaching staff
- Participate in advisory
- Participate in weekly virtual face-to-face meetings with school staff
- Select courses and earn credit to fulfill graduation requirements in order to earn a high school diploma



Remote Alternative for Special Programs (6-12)

2021-22 only

- Students served in special programs
 - Special Education (EBC, IAC, ILC)
 - Dual Language
 - Newcomer English Language Learners
- Grouped with others across the district in similar programs
- Instruction may include
 - Access to live instruction via Zoom
 - Concurrent instruction with in-person peers via Zoom
 - Remote instruction with other remote peers
 - Courses taught through Edgenuity

Secondary Options for 2022-23

For the 2022-23 school year:

- Students enrolled in HVA in 2021-22 will have the option of continuing at HVA or returning to their previous school.
- Students served in special programs and accessing a remote option will return to their previous school/program.



Change of Assignment Process

- Change of Assignment form will be posted online July 1
- Change requests will be accepted through August 2
- Change requests will be approved on space available
- Families will be notified of the outcome of change requests the week of August 16
- Secondary students who request a change to remote will also need to complete the HVA application
