

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF CONSOLIDATED HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT 125, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, HELD IN THE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION CENTER ON MONDAY, APRIL 19, 2021, AT 7:30 P.M.
