













## ELEVATIONS



#### Materials

Ground Face block – used at lower elevations and areas of importance; emulates limestone.

Brick - Traditional building material used in the neighborhood.

EIFS – Economical building material; very similar to stucco; used in higher elevations.

Shingles - Traditional roof covering used in the neighborhood.


