Summary of the Curriculum and Instruction Committee meeting held on Wednesday, May 21, 2020 at 11:30 a.m. via Zoom. Directors Larson and Lee were present. Administrators present were Jared Cordon, Michelle Knee and Dani Jardine.

Call to Order: Director Larson acted on behalf of Director Hall and called the meeting to order at 11:36 a.m.

Elementary Math Adoption

Director of Teaching and Learning, Michelle Knee highlighted the process that began in September for elementary math adoption. The search was narrowed down by the Standards Expert Committee and the Adoption Committee, from four recommended programs, to pilot Into Math and Ready Math together. Committee members accessed the pilot and teacher's observation data from the Google classroom platform evaluating each programs strengths and weaknesses. Voting results in April revealed, 26 responses unanimously chose Ready Classroom Mathematics. The piloting committee would like to present to the Board, Ready Math as the selection for the elementary math adoption.

The committee agrees Ready Classroom is the best choice because:

- Students are more engaged, able to become more of a mathematician through use of the habits and routines of these math practice standards.
- Students are equipped to develop a better understanding of the standards, being challenged, but not defeated.
- Teachers were able to easily navigate online and print materials.
- Teachers were able to ask more purposeful and targeted questions.
- Teachers were able to differentiate and select in sequence productive mathematical discussions.
- Teachers were able to smoothly facilitate learning from conceptual understanding to procedural fluency.

This is a 6-year adoption. The Ready Classroom quote includes student materials, teacher materials, online access, continued access to the IReady diagnostic and instructional piece.

The committee makes the recommendation to submit this adoption to the Board.
