Tarea: Reflexión personal de la novela

El examen de AP Español Lengua y Cultura cubre seis temas:

- Belleza y estética
- La vida contemporánea
- Familias y comunidades
- Retos o problemas globales
- Identidades privadas versus públicas
- La ciencia y tecnología

In addition to reading the novel, you are going to record your personal reflections and analysis in Spanish. The structure of this assignment is flexible; however, you should highlight, but are not limited to, the six themes mentioned above.

Option 1: You may create a traditional journal, written from your point of view with summaries, questions, and literary analyses (including symbolism, connections to the AP themes, character development, etc.). This journal may be hand-written or digital. If you choose a digital route, you may incorporate different media (written reflections, video responses, links to relevant external sources, etc.).

Option 2: You may create a journal or scrapbook written from the perspective of a character or characters in the novel. If you choose this route, you may incorporate a variety of techniques (video reflections, collage, links to relevant external sources, hypothetical questions, or reactions to specific scenes, etc.)

Option 3: You may write a personal reflection on how/if you relate to a specific character's experience. In doing so, you would need to provide concrete examples from your own experiences and compare or contrast them with the chosen character.

Alternatively, you could reflect on how cultural and/or familial traditions impact an adolescent's transition into a young adult and then could compare your experience with a chosen character.

At the end of the first week of classes, you will present your project to the class (7-10 minutes) and these presentations will serve as an introduction to an in-depth discussion of the novel.
