# Greater Seattle Regional Helplines & Shelters

## **YWCA Seattle/King/Snohomish**

Call: 206-461-4882 (24 hour shelter intake hotline)

Offers safe and confidential housing for women and families who are experiencing domestic violence. This is a short-term emergency shelter program for female survivors, as well as transgender and gender non-conforming individuals and children. Services for male survivors of DV are available (such as motel vouchers and other housing assistance).

## **SNOHOMISH COUNTY**

### **Providence Sexual Assault Center**

Provides services to victims of sexual and physical abuse and their families with support from law enforcement, child protective services, victim advocacy, prosecution and mental health agencies.

### **Domestic Violence Services of Snohomish County**

Offers emergency shelter, supportive housing, legal advocacy, support groups, outreach and preventative education for victims of domestic violence.
