4. SIC Report
 - a. Met on January 6th – proposal for small groups
 - i. Have students come in one day a week
 - ii. Students here the full day
 - iii. Proposed a time line
 - iv. Faculty presentation on Friday
 - v. February 1st will be the first day to start this program
 - vi. Remote learning still taking place
5. Clayton Reopening Timeline
 - a. February 1st – 7th & 8th graders return to school – January 28th to February 24th or until Board approval.
 - b. 25% of students come each day, except Wednesday
 - c. Wednesday devoted to students in remote learning and small groups on Zoom as needed
 - d. In-person once a week (*number of students based on 650 students, likely to be smaller)
 - i. Monday – A-E – 167 students
 - ii. Tuesday – F-K – 152 students
 - iii. Wednesday – work with remote students, PLCs, planning
 - iv. Thursday – L-Q – 159 students
 - v. Friday – R-Z – 171 students
 - e. Students will need to bring the following
 - i. Laptop charged
 - ii. Water bottle
 - iii. Binder

- iv. Writing tools
 - v. Come dressed to play (PE/Dance/Yoga/etc.)
 - f. Lockers and gym lockers will not be used
 - g. At school for the full day
 - h. Continue quality remote learning via Zoom during synchronous times
 - i. Students working in your classroom on same assignments as remote students during asynchronous time
 - j. Teachers plan for remote learning using Canvas
 - k. Work with remote students on Wednesdays
 - l. Buddy system, overflow plan in case of unbalanced classes
 - m. Social Distancing Guidelines
 - n. Student seating chart allows for 6 ft distance
 - o. Maximum capacity is determined by class size
 - p. Parents will assume their students are distanced; we need to honor that.
