

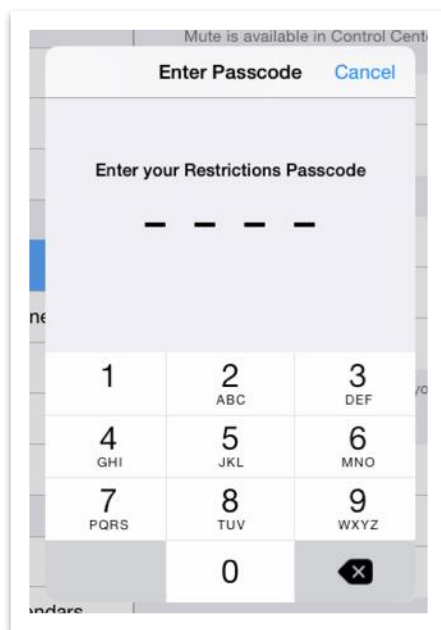


General Parental Control Restrictions Setup



1. In Settings, click  **Touch ID & Passcode** and **Turn Passcode Off** if it is on. It should now say **Turn Passcode On**
2. Click  **Screen Time** and click **Use Screen Time Passcode**
3. Set your child's passcode based on their grade level.
PLEASE DO NOT TELL THIS PASSCODE TO THE STUDENTS

You may have a restrictions passcode set already. If so, please click **Change Screen Time Passcode** and enter the New Passcode based on your child's grade level

Keeping the passcode the same for the grade level ensures that faculty can help students when needed.

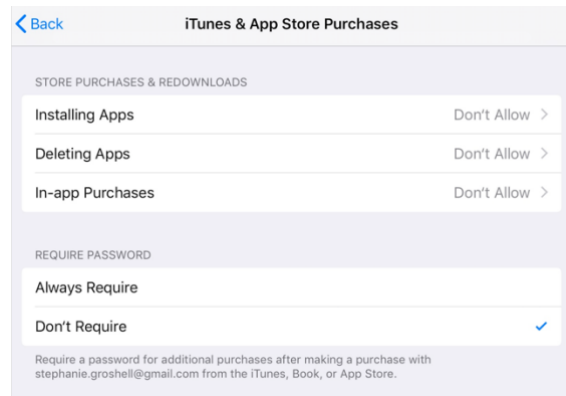
4. Click  **Content & Privacy Restrictions**

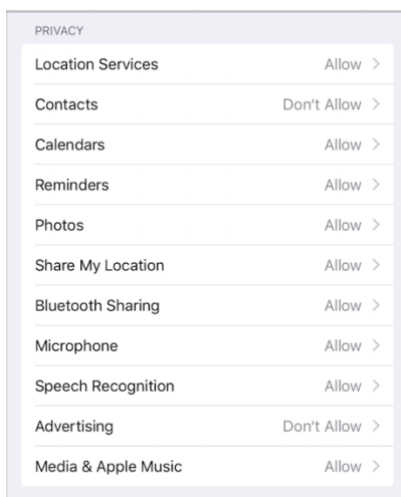
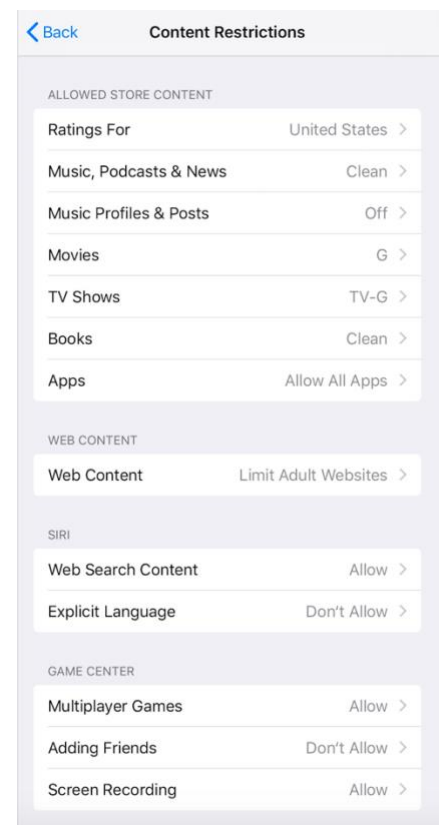
6. In iTunes & App Store Purchases:

- Turn **Installing Apps**, **Deleting Apps** and **In-App Purchases** to **Don't Allow**
- Turn **Require Password** to **Don't Require**



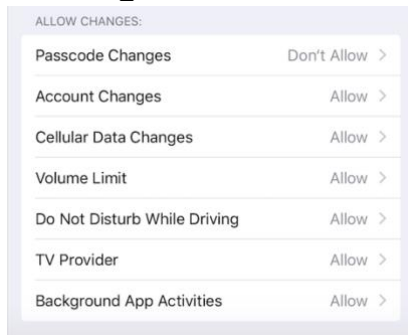
7. In Content Restrictions, set the following:

- **Allowed Store Content:**
 - **Music, Podcasts & News** to **Clean**
 - **Music Profiles & Posts** to **Off**
 - **Movies** to **G**
 - **TV Shows** to **TV-G**
 - **Books** to **Clean**
 - **Apps** to **Allow All Apps**
- **Web Content** to **Limit Adult Websites**
- **Siri:**
 - **Web Search Content** to **Allow**
 - **Explicit Language** to **Don't Allow**
- **Game Center:**
 - **Multiplayer Games** to **Allow**
 - **Adding Friends** to **Don't Allow**
 - **Screen Recording** to **Allow**



8. In Privacy set **Contacts** and **Advertising** to **Don't Allow**

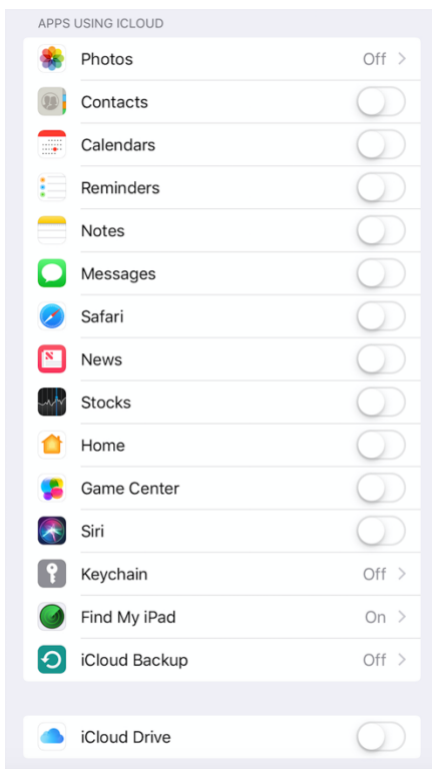
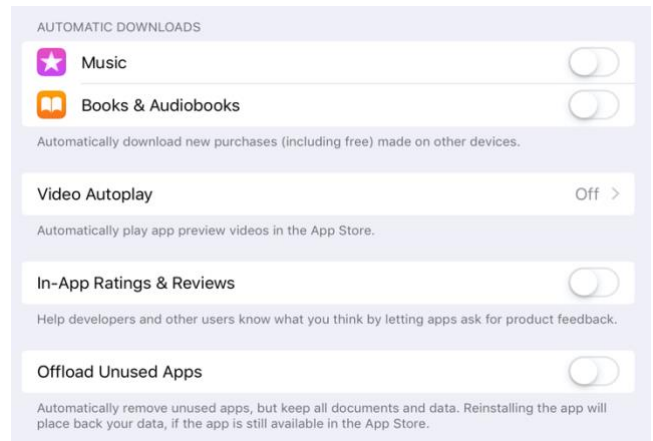

9. In **Allow Changes**, set **Passcode Changes** to **Don't Allow**

10. Click **iTunes & App Store**

- Set **Automatic Downloads**:
 - **Music** to **OFF**
 - **Books & Audiobooks** to **OFF**
- **Video Autoplay** to **OFF**
- **In-App Ratings & Reviews** to **OFF**
- **Offload Unused Apps** to **OFF**



11. Go to **iCloud**

a. If your child is sharing your Apple ID account:

- Turn **Find My iPad** **ON**
- Turn all other items **OFF**

b. If you have set up **Family Sharing** (recommended) and your child has their own account, everything can stay **ON**

If you get this message, click **Delete from My iPad**





12. Click **Messages** and turn it **OFF**

13. Click **FaceTime** and turn it **OFF**

14. Click  **General**
 - a. Select AirDrop
 - i. Set to **Everyone**
 - b. Select Language & Region
 - i. Set iPad Language to **English**
