

## **Tipton-Rosemark Academy Senior Service Project Overview**

The TRA Senior Service Project has four components:

- 1) summer service work (20 hours - independent work)
- 2) project (30 hours - group work)
- 3) portfolio
- 4) presentation

### **Project**

Your project has three phases, all of which will be completed by the end of the first semester.

#### **A. Create the proposal**

- With your team, identify a community need
- Develop an action plan to meet this need
- Collect resources necessary to complete the project
- Make a timeline and a schedule for completion

#### **B. Implement the activity**

- Put your action plan into practice
- Keep track of your effort in a log
- Keep records of your work – photos, videos, sketches, etc.

#### **C. Evaluate and reflect on your experience and the changes that were made in the plan**

- What benefits did the community gain?
- How did you gain from this experience?
- What changes occurred in the community because of your project?

### **The Portfolio**

You will prepare a portfolio of your activities and progress. Included in the portfolio will be your:

- Checklist
- Proposal
- Time Log
- Presentation Materials
- Reflection Paper
- Teacher Portfolio Evaluation Rubric (blank) to be completed by your Faculty Advisor

### **The Presentation**

Before the end of the first semester, you will present your project to a panel of faculty members.
