St. Catherine's School Uniform List for Preparatory School Academic year 2021-2022

Girls are ambassadors for the school and their uniform should be correct and smart at all times.

Throughout the uniform list there are no recommended numbers for each item. Parents are free to purchase the number to suit their own laundry/boarding arrangements. Do remember that the PTAs run a second-hand shop where many of these items may also be purchased.

All items are available from the School shop unless marked with an asterisk*.

Please note that washing instructions for some of the kit and uniform needs to be followed carefully as the use of fabric softeners adversely affects the waterproofing.

Labelling

All items must be named. For ease of returning lost property it would aid us greatly if clothing is named in the locations stipulated on the list. **Labels can be ordered through the School Shop** and should be black on white. For the girls in F1 and above it is advisable to have one-inch name tapes for the sports bags and back pack – navy on white.

You may **also** wish to write your daughter's name on the inside of the garment itself using a permanent marker just in case the name label should become detached from the garment.

Hair must be worn off the face. Navy hairbands/clips can be purchased at the school shop. Exaggerated styles and colours are not allowed.

Jewellery allowed with school uniform is a watch, a plain cross and chain, plain stud earrings and any Medicare item. We recommend that any initial or additional piercing, with parental permission, should only be done at the start of the summer holiday so that proper healing can take place before the start of term.

IPads

iPads are a compulsory item for girls in UII to Upper 5. The current minimum requirements for an iPad to be used at school are:

- 5th Generation(2018) iPad or iPad Pro with screen size of 9.7" or larger. An iPad mini is not recommended for school.
- Storage capacity of 64GB or greater to ensure that the iPad will comfortably handle three years use and the weight of materials we expect the girls to store: educational film clips, e-books, photographs etc.
- Functioning battery life of 6+ hours to last the school day
- Visibly good condition

Your daughter's iPad should <u>not</u> try to emulate the look and feel of a "miniature laptop". When on a desk, it should be operable at a low profile and not create an upright barrier to focus and communication with the teacher. Please consider this when choosing a suitable case.



- Beware cases with built-in keyboards which are often bulky and heavy. If chosen, they must be able to fold to a shallow slant for use in lessons.
- The school iPad purchasing portal runs every year during the summer term.
- A new iPad in Upper 3 should typically last three to four years, requiring a single replacement approximately halfway through the Senior School.

If you purchase your own iPad separately, we ask that it be a Wi-Fi and not a 3G/4G device. Our firewall protection for our students, and restricted access to social media sites, can only be applied to Wi-Fi devices.

Navy boot bag	From F1 for extracurricular hockey, football or lacrosse clubs. Named on the outside. Instead of the boot bag girls can also use the pre-prep sports bag.
Football boots with plastic studs*	From F1 for extracurricular hockey, football or lacrosse clubs. Named on the inside sole or with laundry marker.
Mouth guard	From F1 for extracurricular hockey, football or lacrosse clubs.
Shin pads*	From F1 for extracurricular hockey, football or lacrosse clubs. Clearly labelled.
Navy hockey socks	From F1 for extracurricular hockey, football or lacrosse clubs. Label on the sole. Do not use iron on labels on the hockey socks.

The School Shop

School uniform has to be obtained from the School Shop on site at St. Catherine's School. It is situated in the Business Centre and can be accessed via a path to the left of the Business Centre building. The uniform can be purchased by:

1. <u>Pre- booked appointments</u> – These are highly advisable if you need to purchase a larger number of items, or if you are not sure about the sizing of the uniform. Please send an email to <u>school.shop@stcatherines.info</u> to book an appointment and we will get back to you.

We understand that getting new uniform is a joyful occasion for our new joiners particularly and in the past we have seen bigger groups coming together, but under new circumstances we would like to remind you that our shop area is not suitable to follow social distancing rules when more than 3 people are present in the Shop - <u>please do not come with younger siblings, grandparents etc.</u> if possible. We would prefer it if you came with one parent/adult and girl in the group. We will be very happy for you to take photographs of the occasion if you wish to send to other family members.

2. <u>Remote purchase</u> – we strongly advise this route if you need just a few items. Send your order requirements to <u>school.shop@stcatherines.info</u> and we will get in touch with you to discuss your order in more detail, take the payment and arrange the time for the collection. Items can always be exchanged if not worn and returned in original packaging.
