Traffic and Safety—Pro Tips

School is up and running, and for the most part traffic is going well. We have some input for having an even safer drop off and pick up. Anyone who co-ops, drops off, or walks their child(ren) into school, NO JAYWALKING with or without children.

Only drop off/pick up in the clear space up front. This is where, our eyes are and this is going to be quickest—we promise. Please do not let your kids get out early and cross the flags. For pickup: we ask that you pull around the block if your child is not on the curb ready to be picked up. We recommend doing it after two minutes to keep the line moving.

Pull all the way forward to drop off and pick up, we suggest that you turn your wheels out when you pull up for easier exit. Children may be circling in front or behind your car. Please stay aware of them any time they are off the sidewalk. Tell your kids it is better to walk in front of their own vehicle if they need to go around.


We are happy to open the door, help kids with their stuff, and close the door. Do not get out of the car in the zone. Be ready when you get to the front of the line. The faster your kids hop out and get safely to the sidewalk, the faster you can safely merge out of there.

There is a ton of traffic for about 20 minutes each morning and afternoon. Try to clear the loading zone as quickly as possible to keep it moving.
